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STATEMENT OF THE CASE

In Case No. 22287, Applicant applies for an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying a 480-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2 of Section 19, Township 19 South, Range 28 East, and the SE/4 of Section 24, Township 19 South, Range 27 East in Eddy County, New Mexico ("Unit"). The

Unit will be dedicated to the Lightfoot 19 State Com 222H and Lightfoot 19 State Com 232H to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 19 to a bottom hole location in the NW/4SE/4 (Unit J) of Section 24, and the Lightfoot 19 State Com 221H and Lightfoot 19 State Com 231H to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SE/4SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 19 to a bottom hole location in the SW/4SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 24. The completed intervals of the Wells will be orthodox. The completed interval for the Lightfoot 19 State Com 231H will be within 330' of the line separating the S/2S/2 and N/2S/2 of Section 19 allowing for the creation of a 480-acre standard horizontal spacing unit. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the Wells and the allocation of the costs, the designation of Applicant as the operator of the Wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the Wells. The Wells are located approximately 18 miles Southeast of Artesia, New Mexico.

In Case No. 22288, Applicant applies for an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying a 240-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2N/2 of Section 19, Township 19 South, Range 28 East, and the S/2NE/4 of Section 24, Township 19 South, Range 27 East in Eddy County, New Mexico ("Unit"). The Unit will be dedicated to the Lightfoot 19 State Com 223H and Lightfoot 19 State Com 233H wells which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SE/4NE/4 (Unit H) of Section 19 to a bottom hole location in the SW/4NE/4 (Unit G) of Section 24 ("Wells"). The completed intervals of the Wells will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the Wells and the allocation of the costs, the designation of Applicant as the operator of the Wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the Wells. The Wells are located approximately 18 miles Southeast of Artesia, New Mexico.

In Case No. 22289, Applicant applies for an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying a 240-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2N/2 of Section 19, Township 19 South, Range 28 East, and the N/2NE/4 of Section 24, Township 19 South, Range 27 East in Eddy County, New Mexico ("Unit"). The Unit will be dedicated to the Lightfoot 19 State Com 224H and Lightfoot 19 State Com 234H wells which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4NE/4 (Unit A) of Section 19 to a bottom hole location in the NW/4NE/4 (Unit B) of Section 24 ("Wells"). The completed intervals of the Wells will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the Wells and the allocation of the costs, the designation of Applicant as the operator of the Wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the Wells. The Wells are located approximately 18 miles Southeast of Artesia, New Mexico.
