### SELF-AFFIRMED STATEMENT OF MATTHEW PHILLIPS

- 1. My name is Matthew Phillips, and I am the land manager at Tap Rock Operating, LLC ("TRO"). I am over 18 years of age and am competent to provide this Self-Affirmed Statement. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") and my credentials as a petroleum landman have been accepted and made a matter of record.
- 2. I am familiar with the land matters involved in the above-referenced case. Copies of TRO's application and proposed hearing notice are attached as **Exhibit A-1**.
- 3. In this case, TRO seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the PURPLE SAGE WOLFCAMP GAS POOL [98220] within the Wolfcamp formation underlying a 640-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit ("Unit") comprised of the S/2 of Sections 13 and 14, Township 25 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.
  - 4. The Unit will be dedicated to the following proposed initial wells ("Wells"):
    - Cold Snack Federal Com #214H and Cold Snack Federal Com #234H to be horizontally drilled from a surface hole location in the NW/4SW/4 of Section 14 to a bottom hole location in the SE/4SE/4 of Section 13, and
    - Cold Snack Federal Com #213H and Cold Snack Federal Com #233H to be horizontally drilled from a surface hole location in the NW/4SW/4 of Section 14 to a bottom hole location in the NE/4SE/4 of Section 13.

- 5. **Exhibit A-2** contains Form C-102s for the Wells which demonstrate the completed intervals of the Wells will be orthodox.
- 6. **Exhibit A-3** contains a plat of the tracts included in the Unit and includes any applicable lease numbers, a recapitulation of the ownership interests within the Unit, and the interests TRO seeks to pool.
- 7. **Exhibit A-4** contains a sample well proposal letter and AFEs sent to working interest owners for the Wells. The estimated costs reflected on the AFEs are fair and reasonable and comparable to the cost of other wells of similar depth and length drilled in the subject formation in the area.
- 8. TRO conducted a diligent search of all public records in the county where the proposed wells are located and of phone directories, including computer searches.
- 9. In my opinion, TRO made a good-faith effort to reach voluntary joinder of uncommitted interests in the Wells as indicated by the chronology of contact described in **Exhibit A-**5.
- 10. TRO requests overhead and administrative rates of \$8,000 per month while the Wells are being drilled and \$800 per month while the Wells are producing. These rates are fair and are comparable to the rates charged by TRO and other operators in the vicinity.
- 11. Notice of this application and the Division hearing was timely provided to the uncommitted interests by certified mail more than 20 days prior to the hearing date. **Exhibit A-6** contains a sample of the notice letters, a list of the parties who were notified of this hearing and the status of whether they received notice.
- 12. Notice of this application and the Division hearing was published more than ten business days prior to the hearing date. The affidavit of publication is attached as **Exhibit A-7.**

- 13. In my opinion, granting TRO's application will serve the interests of conservation, the protection of correlative rights, and the prevention of waste.
- 14. The attached exhibits were either prepared by me or compiled under my direction and supervision.
- 15. I understand this Self-Affirmed Statement will be used as written testimony in this case. I affirm that my testimony in paragraphs 1 through 14 above is true and correct and is made under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of New Mexico. #### <u>APPLICATION</u>

Pursuant to NMSA § 70-2-17, Tap Rock Operating, LLC ("TRO") (OGRID No. 372043) applies for an order pooling all uncommitted interests within the Wolfcamp formation underlying a 640-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit ("Unit") comprised of the S/2 of Sections 13 and 14, Township 25 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. In support of its application, TRO states:

- 1. TRO is a working interest owner in the Unit and has the right to drill wells thereon.
- 2. The Unit will be dedicated to the following proposed initial wells ("Wells") which it intends to drill simultaneously:
  - Cold Snack Federal Com #214H and Cold Snack Federal Com #234H to be horizontally drilled from a surface hole location in the NW/4SW/4 of Section 14 to a bottom hole location in the SE/4SE/4 of Section 13,
  - Cold Snack Federal Com #213H and Cold Snack Federal Com #233H to be horizontally drilled from a surface hole location in the NW/4SW/4 of Section 14 to a bottom hole location in the NE/4SE/4 of Section 13.

- B. Approving the initial Wells in the Unit;
- C. Designating TRO as operator of this Unit and the Wells to be drilled thereon;
- D. Authorizing TRO to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the Wells;
- E. Approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedures; and
- F. Imposing a 200% penalty for the risk assumed by TRO in drilling and completing the Wells against any working interest owner who does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of the Wells.

SELF-AFFIRMED STATEMENT OF ELI DENBESTEN

1. I am over the age of 18 and have personal knowledge of the matters stated

herein. I am employed as a petroleum geologist for Tap Rock Operating, LLC ("Tap Rock")

and am familiar with the subject application and the geology matters involved. I have testified

before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division in the past and my credentials as an expert

in petroleum geology matters was accepted and made a matter of record.

2. **Exhibit B-1** is a Project Locator Map depicting the location of the Horizontal

Spacing Units ("Units") in the Delaware Basin within Sections 13 and 14, Township 25 South,

Range 25 East, dedicated to the Cold Snack Federal Com #211H, 212H, 213H, 214H, 231H,

232H, 233H and 234H wells (the "Wells").

3. **Exhibit B-2** is a Gun Barrel Diagram showing the planned Wolfcamp

horizontal spacing for the Wells. A nearby type log has been included to show approximate

depths and reservoir quality of the landing zones.

4. **Exhibit B-3** is a Wolfcamp structure map in subsea vertical depth. This map

shows the location of the Units outlined by red boxes. The surface/bottom hole locations of the

Wells are shown, zoomed in, to the right. The contour intervals are 25 feet each. Structure is

down dipping from west to east through the Units. The orientation of the Wells will be

approximately perpendicular to the down dipping structure. There are no nearby wells within

the map extent that have targeted the equivalent intervals in the Wolfcamp. The vertical wells

controlling the structure map have the subsea vertical depth posted in black. The subsequent cross-section from A-A' is also identified. I do not observe any faulting, pinch-outs, or other geologic impediments or hazards to developing this targeted interval utilizing horizontal wells.

- 5. **Exhibit B-4** is a Wolfcamp Stratigraphic Cross Section (flattened on the Wolfcamp A Lower). The exhibit contains a gamma ray log, deep resistivity log, and porosity track for each well. This exhibit identifies the key tops used to evaluate reservoirs and landing targets for the Wells. Peach circles on the depth track of Well 3 show the landing target intervals for the Wells.
- 6. **Exhibit B-5** is an Isopach Map of the targeted intervals. This map shows the location of the Units outlined by red boxes. The surface/bottom hole location of the Wells are shown, zoomed in, to the right. The anticipated gross thickness of the interval is 2225-2280' throughout the Units. The contour intervals are 25'. The location of the previous cross-section from A-A' is also shown on this map.
  - 7. Based on my geologic study of the area, I conclude the following:
  - a. The Units are justified from a geologic standpoint;
  - There are no structural impediments or faulting that will interfere with horizontal development;
  - c. Each quarter-quarter section in the Units will contribute more or less equally to production;
  - d. The preferred well orientation in this area is east-west since the inferred orientation of the maximum horizontal stress is roughly north-south.
- 8. The attached Exhibits were either prepared by me, compiled under my direction and supervision, or compiled from company business records.

- 9. The granting of this Application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.
- 10. I understand this Self-Affirmed Statement will be used as written testimony in this case. 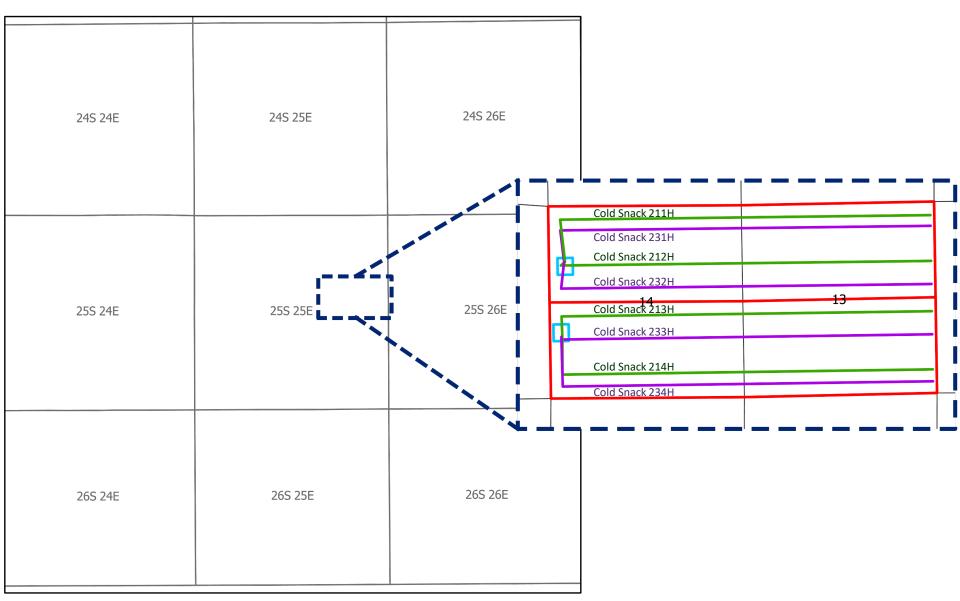

### Projecty Locator Map - Cold Snack Fed Com Wolfcamp



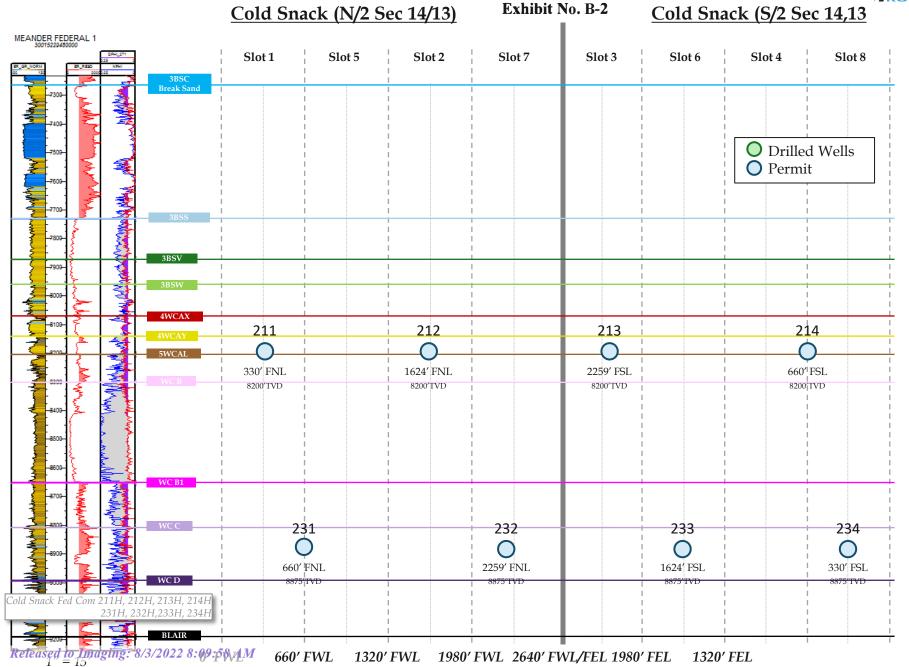

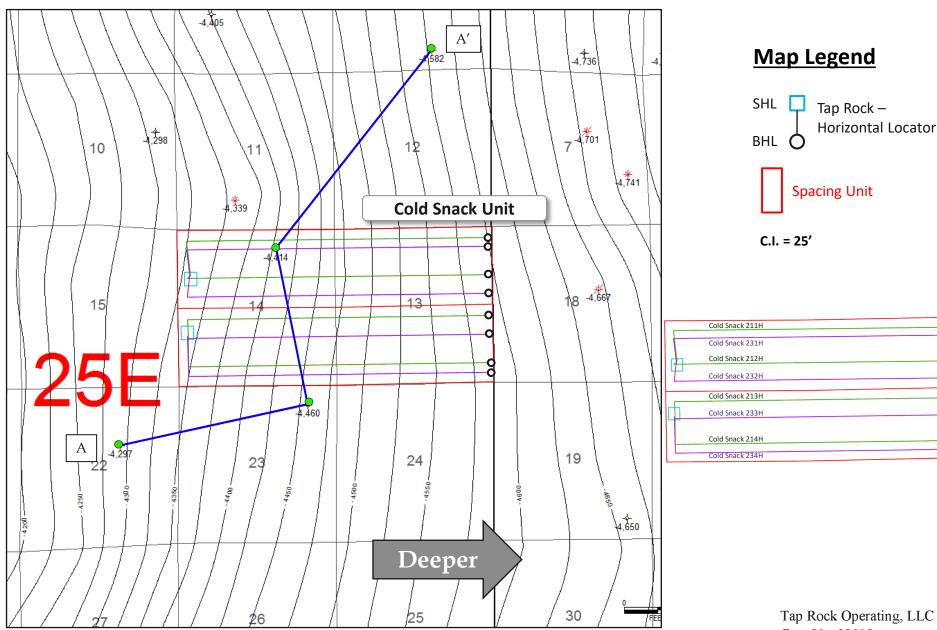

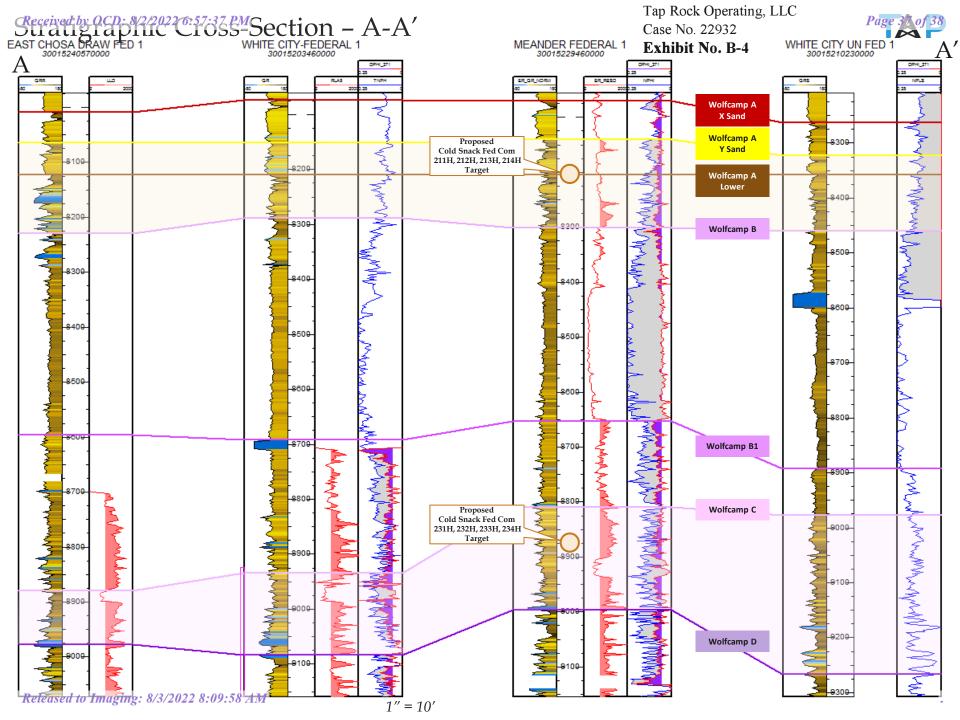
### Teseivet Wolfe & Structure Map; CI=25']

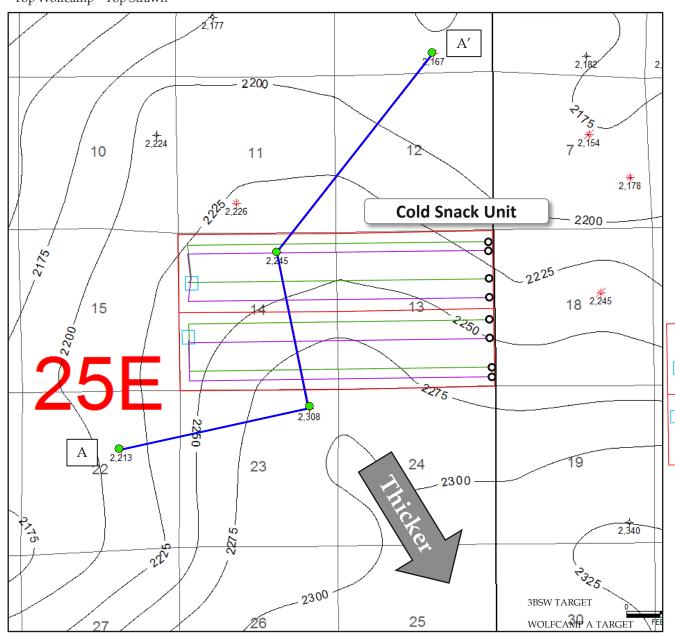

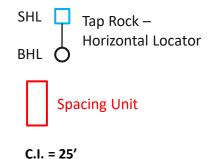
### Cross Wolfcamps [Isopach Map; CI=25']
