Order No. R-22185 pooled mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying a 635.20-acre (proximity tract) horizontal spacing unit comprised of Lots 1-4 and the S/2N/2 (the N/2) of Section 1 and Lots 1-4 and the S/2N/2 (the N/2) of Section 2, Township 20 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, for the purpose of drilling (i) the Desert Eagle 1/2 B2AD Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, with a first take point in the NE/4NE/4 of Section 1 and last take point in the NW/4NW/4 of Section 2, (ii) the Desert Eagle 1/2 B2HE Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, with a first take point in the SE/4NE/4 of Section 1 and last take point in the SW/4NW/4 of Section 2, and (iii) the Desert Eagle 1/2 B3AD Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, with a first take point in the NE/4NE/4 of Section 1 and last take point in the NW/4NW/4 of Section 2.

Well No. 1H and the Desert Eagle 1/2 B31L Fed Com. Well No. 1H to depths sufficient to test the Bone Spring formation, with first take points in the NE/4SE/4 of Section 1 and last take points in the NW/4SW/4 of Section 2.

Well No. 1H to a depth sufficient to test the Wolfcamp formation, with a first take point in the SE/4SE/4 of Section 1 and a last take point in the SW/4SW/4 of Section 2.
