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To: Wellfleet Investment Fund II, LP, or your successors or assigns: Mewbourne Oil Company has filed an application with the Oil Conservation Division (Case No. 23692) seeking an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2S/2 of Section 36 and the N/2SE/4 of Section 35, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, NMPM Eddy County, New Mexico. The unit will be dedicated to the Gemini 36/35 B21J Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, a horizontal well with a first take point in the NE/4SE/4 of Section 36 and a last take point in the NW/4SE/4 of Section 35. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling, completing, testing, and equipping the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling, completing, testing, and equipping the well. This matter is scheduled for hearing on September 7, 2023 at 8:15 a.m. During the current circumstances, state buildings are closed to the public and the hearing will be conducted remotely.
