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**APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF THE CASE**

In **Case No. 25214**, EOG seeks an order to amend Order No. R-23200 ("Pooling Order") to allow for an extension of time for drilling the proposed initial wells under the Pooling Order. On May 15, 2024, the Division issued Order R-23200 in Case 22947, creating a standard 640-acre, more or less, overlapping horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2 of Sections 23 and 26, Township 24 South, Range 34 East, Lea County, New Mexico (the "Unit"), and designated EOG as operator of the Unit. Order No. R-23200 further pooled the uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation (Red Hills; Bone Spring, North Pool [96434]) in the Unit and dedicated the Unit

to the proposed initial **Grackle 26 East Fed Com #101H** (API No. 30-025-PENDING), **Grackle 26 East Fed Com #102H** (API No. 30-025-54036), **Grackle 26 East Fed Com #103H** (API No. 30- 025-54037), **Grackle 26 East Fed Com #301H** (API No. 30-025-PENDING), **Grackle 26 East Fed Com #302H** (API No. 30-025-PENDING), **Grackle 26 East Fed Com #303H** (API No. 30- 025-PENDING), **Grackle 26 East Fed Com #304H** (API No. 30-025-PENDING), and the **Grackle 26 East Fed Com #305H** (API No. 30-025-PENDING).

There is good cause for Applicant's request for an extension of time to drill. EOG previously submitted federal permits but has yet to receive approval from the Bureau of Land Management ("BLM").
