- A. **Case No. 25603: Application by Matador Production Company for a de novo hearing on Division Order No. R-23869/Division Case Nos. 25283-84**, regarding the Application of Permian Resources Operating, LLC for Compulsory Pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying 320-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of Lot 3, NE/2 SW/4, N/2 SE/4 (N/2 S/2 equivalent) of irregular Section 7, and the N/2 S/2 of Section 8, Township 20 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico (“Unit”). The Unit will be dedicated to the Fiero 7 Fed Com 133H well (“Well”), which will be drilled from a surface hole location in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 9 to a bottom hole location in the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 7. The completed interval of the Well will be orthodox. The Well is located approximately 11.3 miles northwest of Carlsbad, New Mexico.

- D. **Case No. 25694: Application by American Energy Resources for a de novo hearing on Division Order No. R-23961/Division Case No. 25166**, regarding the Amended Application of Alpha Energy Partners II, LLC, for Compulsory Pooling, of all uncommitted mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation, designated as a gas pool, underlying a standard 1267.84-acre, more or less, horizontal spacing and proration unit comprised of the Sections 17 and 18 in Township 22 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. The proposed wells to be dedicated to the horizontal spacing unit are the Hollywood Star 17-18 Fee 701H Well to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 16 to a bottom hole location in Lot 4 (SW/4SW/4) of Section 18; the Hollywood Star 17-18 Fee 702H Well to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 16 to a bottom hole location in Lot 3 (NW/4SW/4) of Section 18; the Hollywood Star 17-18 Fee 703H Well to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 16 to a bottom hole location in Lot 2 (SW/4NW/4) of Section 18; the Hollywood Star 17-18 Fee 704H Well to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 16 to a bottom hole location in Lot 1 (NW/4NW/4) of Section 18; the Hollywood Star 17-18 Fee 801H Well to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 16 to a bottom hole location in Lot 3 (NW/4SW/4) of Section 18; the Hollywood Star 17-18 Fee 802H Well to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 16 to a bottom hole location in Lot 2 (SW/4NW/4) of Section 18; and the Hollywood Star 17-18 Fee 803H Well to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 16 to a bottom hole location in

the Lot 1 (NW/4NW/4) of Section 18. The 802H Well is the proximity well, and proximity tracts will be utilized. All the proposed wells will be orthodox, and their take points and completed intervals will comply with the special rules for the Purple Sage, Wolfcamp pool pursuant to Order No. R-14262. The wells and lands are located approximately 1.5 miles south-southeast from Carlsbad, New Mexico.

**E. Case No. 25695: Application by American Energy Resources for a de novo hearing on Division Order No. R-23989//Division Case No. 25496**, regarding the Application of Alpha Energy Partners II, LLC, for Compulsory Pooling of all uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation, designated as an oil pool, underlying a standard 316.92-acre, more or less, horizontal spacing and proration unit comprised of the S/2 N/2 Sections 17 and 18 in Township 22 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. The proposed wells to be dedicated to the horizontal spacing unit are the Hollywood Star 17-18 Fee 503H Well, an oil well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 16 to a bottom hole location in Lot 2 (SW/4 NW/4) of Section 18; and the Hollywood Star 17-18 Fee 553H Well, an oil well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 16 to a bottom hole location in Lot 2 (SW/4 NW/4) of Section 18. The proposed wells will be orthodox, and their take points and completed intervals will comply with statewide rules. The wells and lands are located approximately 1.5 miles south-southeast from Carlsbad, New Mexico.

**F. Case No. 25696: Application by American Energy Resources for a de novo hearing on Division Order No. R-23977//Division Case No. 25495**, regarding the Application of Alpha Energy Partners II, LLC, for Compulsory Pooling of all uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation, designated as an oil pool, underlying a standard 316.84-acre, more or less, horizontal spacing and proration unit comprised of the N/2 N/2 Sections 17 and 18 in Township 22 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. The proposed wells to be dedicated to the horizontal spacing unit are the Hollywood Star 17-18 Fee 504H Well, an oil well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 16 to a bottom hole location in Lot 1 (NW/4 NW/4) of Section 18; and the Hollywood Star 17-18 Fee 554H Well, an oil well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 16 to a bottom hole location in Lot 1 (NW/4 NW/4) of Section 18. The proposed wells will be orthodox, and their take points and completed intervals will comply with statewide rules. The wells and lands are located approximately 1.5 miles south-southeast from Carlsbad, New Mexico.
