APPLICATION

Matador Production Company (“Matador” or “Applicant”), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division (“Division”) to amend pooling Order R-21267, as amended, to add an additional record title owner to the pooling order. In support of its application, Matador states:

1. On April 28, 2020 the Division issued Order R-21267 (the “Order”) in Case No. 20904 pooling uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation (Getty; Bone Spring [27470]) underlying the N/2 N/2 of Sections 21 and 22, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. This standard 320-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit is currently dedicated to the drilled and producing **Michael K 21 22 Federal Com 121H** well (API No. 30-015-53689).

2. Subsequently, on May 26, 2021 the Division issued Order R-21267-A in Case No. 21812 amending the Order to conform to the Division’s amended order template and to extend the deadline to commence drilling by one year. Then, on January 26, 2022, the Division issued Order R-21267-B in Case No. 22301 to add a newly identified pooled party. Finally, on December 5, 2022 the Division issued Order R-21267-C in Case No. 22706 to extend the drilling deadline under the Order for good cause.

3. Since the issuance of amended Order R-21267-C, Applicant has sought and been unable to obtain signature on the federal communitization agreement from a record title owner.

4. Pooling this additional record title owner in the spacing unit is necessary to obtain approval of the communitization agreement from the Bureau of Land Management, and to prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on November 13, 2025, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order pooling this additional record title owner under the terms of Order R-21267, as amended.

ORDER

The Director of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“OCD”), having heard this matter through a Hearing Examiner on September 1, 2022, and after considering the testimony, evidence, and recommendation of the Hearing Examiner, issues the following Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Matador Production Company (“Operator”) submitted an application (“Application”) requesting an extension to drill the well(s) as required by Order R-21267.
2. Operator identified the owners of uncommitted interests in oil and gas minerals in the Unit and provided evidence that notice of the Application was given.
3. Operator has demonstrated good cause to extend the deadlines in Order R-21267.
4. The Application was heard by the Hearing Examiner, during which Operator presented evidence through affidavits in support of the Application. No other party presented evidence at the hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5. OCD has jurisdiction to issue this Order pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 70-2-17.
6. Operator satisfied the notice requirements for the Application and the hearing as required by 19.15.4.12 NMAC.
7. OCD satisfied the notice requirements for the hearing as required by 19.15.4.9 NMAC.

ORDER

8. The period to drill the well(s) is extended until April 28, 2023.
9. This Order shall terminate automatically if Operator fails to comply with Paragraph 7 unless prior to termination Operator applies, and OCD grants, to amend Order R-21267 for good cause shown.
10. OCD retains jurisdiction of this matter for the entry of such orders as may be deemed necessary.

11. The remaining provisions of Order R-21267 remain in force or effect.

SELF-AFFIRMED STATEMENT OF VERONICA WARE

1. My name is Veronica Ware and I am employed by MRC Energy Company, an affiliate of Matador Production Company (“Matador”), as a Senior Landman.

2. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division as an expert witness in petroleum land matters. My credentials as a petroleum landman have been accepted by the Division and made a matter of public record.

3. I am familiar with the application filed by Matador in this case and the status of the lands in the subject area.

4. In this case, Matador seeks to add one additional record title owner to be pooled under NMOCD Order No. 21267-C, which pooled the uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation (Getty; Bone Spring [27470]) underlying the N/2 N/2 of Sections 21 and 22, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. This standard 320-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit is currently dedicated to the drilled and producing **Michael K 21 22 Federal Com 121H** well (API No. 30-015-53689).

5. Since the original pooling case, Matador has been unable to receive the signature of one record title owner (McMillan Production Inc., record title owner of federal lease NMNM81929) on the federal communitization agreement for this unit.

6. **Matador Exhibit C-1** contains a tract map for this spacing unit identifying the different leases include in the spacing unit, which is comprised of entirely federal leased minerals.

7. **Matador Exhibit C-2** contains an updated summary of interests reflecting the parties in this existing spacing unit. The first page shows the summary of interests on a unit basis. The second page shows the summary of interests on a tract-by-tract basis. The party that Matador seeks to add to the pooling order under this application is highlighted yellow.

8. **Matador Exhibit C-3** contains a general summary of the contacts with the record title owner that Matador seeks to pool in this case.

9. **Matador Exhibit C-4** contains a chart showing the owners in the spacing unit and whether those owners are already committed to the unit or not and, if so, the type of commitment.

10. Matador has conducted a diligent search of the public records in the county where the property is located and conducted computer searches in an attempt to locate contact information for this record title owner. In my opinion, Matador has undertaken good faith efforts to locate and reach an agreement with this record title owner that Matador is seeking to pool in this case.

11. Matador has provided its outside counsel, Holland and Hart, with the name and address of the record title owner that Matador seeks to pool and instructed that it be notified of this hearing.

12. **Matador Exhibits C-1 through C-4** were either prepared by me or compiled under my direction and supervision.

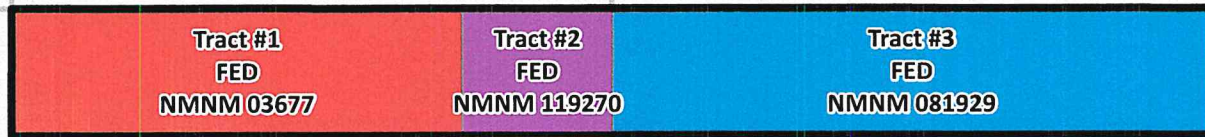


