SELF-AFFIRMED STATEMENT OF BRAXTON BLANDFORD

1. I am a Landman with Mewbourne Oil Company (“Mewbourne”). I am over 18 years of age, have personal knowledge of the matters addressed herein, and am competent to provide this Self-Affirmed Statement. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“Division”), and my credentials as an expert in petroleum land matters were accepted and made a matter of record.

2. I am familiar with the land matters involved in the above-referenced case. Copies of Mewbourne’s Application and proposed hearing notice are attached as **Exhibit A-1**.

3. None of the parties proposed to be pooled indicated opposition to this matter proceeding by affidavit, therefore I do not expect any opposition at hearing.

4. Mewbourne applies for an order pooling all uncommitted interests within the Wolfcamp formation underlying a 480-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2 of Section 24 and the NE/4 of Section 23, Township 23 South, Range 26 East, Eddy County, New Mexico (“Unit”).

5. The Unit will be dedicated to the **Iceman 24/22 Fed Com #712H** well (“Well”), which will be drilled from a surface hole location in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of Section 24 to a bottom hole location in the NW/4 NE/4 (Unit B) of Section 23.

6. The completed interval of the Well will be orthodox.

7. **Exhibit A-2** is the C-102 for the Well.

8. **Exhibit A-3** is a plat that identifies ownership by tract in the Unit. This exhibit also includes any applicable lease numbers, a unit recapitulation, and the interests Mewbourne seeks to pool highlighted in yellow.

9. **Exhibit A-4** is a sample well proposal letter and AFE sent to the working interest owners. The estimated costs reflected on the AFE are fair and reasonable and comparable to the cost of other wells of similar depth and length drilled in the subject formation in the area.

10. Mewbourne has conducted a diligent search of all county public records, including phone directories, internet searches, and computer databases, to identify addresses and contact information for each interest owner it seeks to pool. While Mewbourne believes it located valid addresses for most of the parties it seeks to pool, some of the parties are unlocatable. Mewbourne has provided the names, and last known addresses where applicable, to our outside counsel, Hardy McLean LLC, so that they could attempt notice through certified mail and by publication in the local newspaper.

11. In my opinion, Mewbourne made a good-faith effort to reach voluntary joinder of uncommitted interests in the Well as demonstrated by the chronology of contact provided in **Exhibit A-5**.

12. Mewbourne requests overhead and administrative rates of \$10,000.00 per month while the Well is being drilled and \$1,000.00 per month while the Well is producing. These rates are fair and are comparable to the rates charged by Mewbourne and other operators in the vicinity.

13. The Ownership Commitment Exhibit is attached as **Exhibit A-6**. This exhibit includes a list of all owners in the Unit and identifies each owner's ownership status, whether the owner has committed to the proposed spacing unit, and the type of commitment, *i.e.*, whether a

signed letter of commitment, joint operating agreement, or verbal agreement. Exhibit C also identifies when notice of this hearing was sent to each interest owner by Hardy McLean LLC.


14. The attached exhibits were either prepared by me or under my supervision or were compiled from company business records.

15. In my opinion, the granting of Mewbourne's application would serve the interests of conservation, the protection of correlative rights, and the prevention of waste.

16. I understand this Self-Affirmed Statement will be used as written testimony in this case. I affirm that my testimony above is true and correct and is made under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of New Mexico. APPLICATION

Pursuant to NMSA § 70-2-17, Mewbourne Oil Company, (OGRID No. 14744) (“Mewbourne” or “Applicant”) applies for an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying a 480-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2 of Section 24 and the NE/4 of Section 23, Township 23 South, Range 26 East, Eddy County, New Mexico (“Unit”). In support of its application, Mewbourne states the following.

1. Applicant is a working interest owner in the Unit and has the right to drill wells thereon.
2. The Unit will be dedicated to the **Iceman 24/22 Fed Com #712H** well (“Well”), which will be drilled from a surface hole location in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of Section 24, to a bottom hole location in the NW/4 NE/4 (Unit B) of Section 23.
3. The completed interval of the Well will be orthodox.
4. Applicant has undertaken diligent, good faith efforts to obtain voluntary agreements from all interest owners to participate in the drilling of the Well but has been unable to obtain voluntary agreements from all interest owners.
5. The pooling of uncommitted interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

6. In order to allow Applicant to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, all uncommitted interests in the Unit should be pooled and Applicant should be designated as operator of the Well and the Unit.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on March 5, 2026, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order:

- A. Pooling all uncommitted interests in the Unit;
- B. Approving the Well in the Unit;
- C. Designating Applicant as operator of the Unit and the Well to be drilled thereon;
- D. Authorizing Applicant to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the Well;
- E. Approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedures; and
- F. Imposing a 200% penalty for the risk assumed by Applicant in drilling and completing the Well against any working interest owner who does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of the Well.

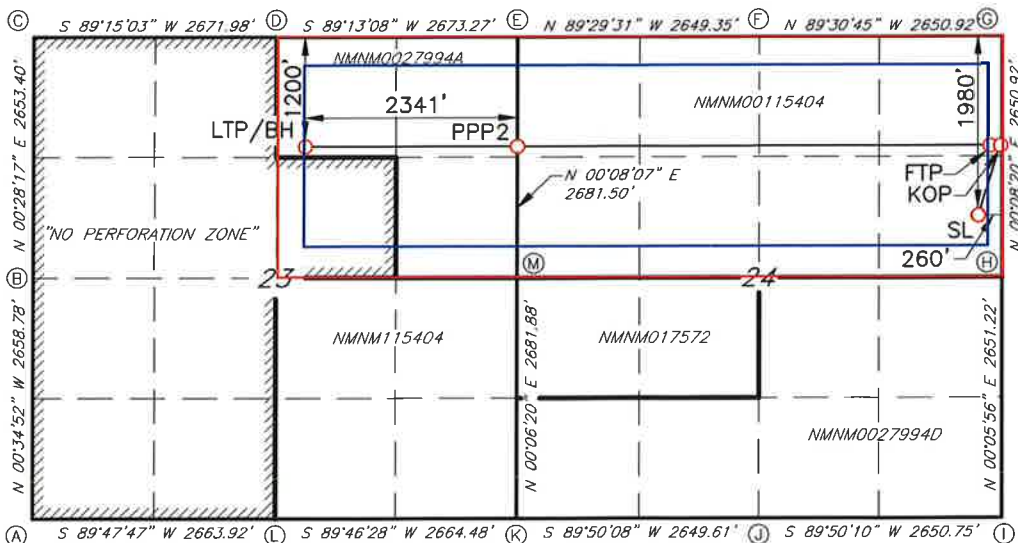

Applicant seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying an 480.00-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2 of Section 24 and the NE/4 of Section 23, Township 23 South, Range 26 East, Eddy County, New Mexico (“Unit”). The Unit will be dedicated to the **Iceman 24/22 Fed Com #712H** well (“Well”), which will be drilled from a surface hole location in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of Section 24, to a bottom hole location in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 23. The completed interval of the Well will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the Well, the allocation of the costs, the designation of Applicant as operator of the Well and the Unit, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the Well. The Well is located approximately 21 miles East-Southeast of Artesia, New Mexico.

ACREAGE DEDICATION PLATS

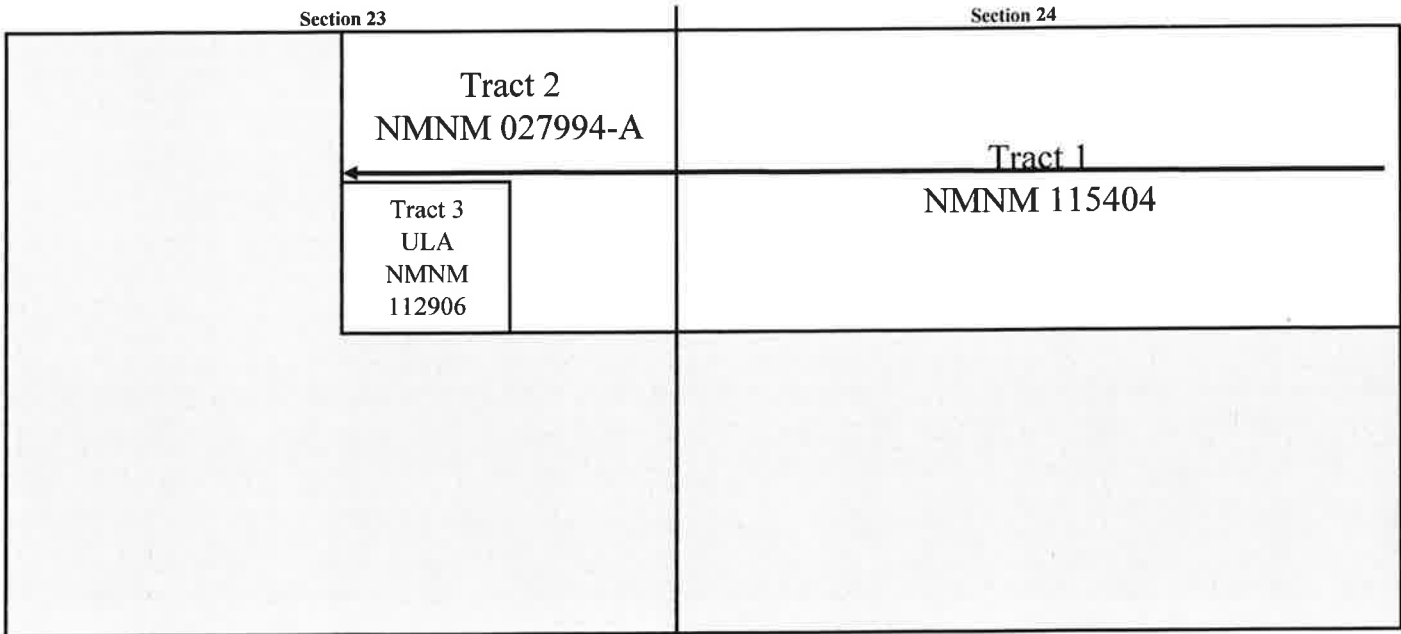

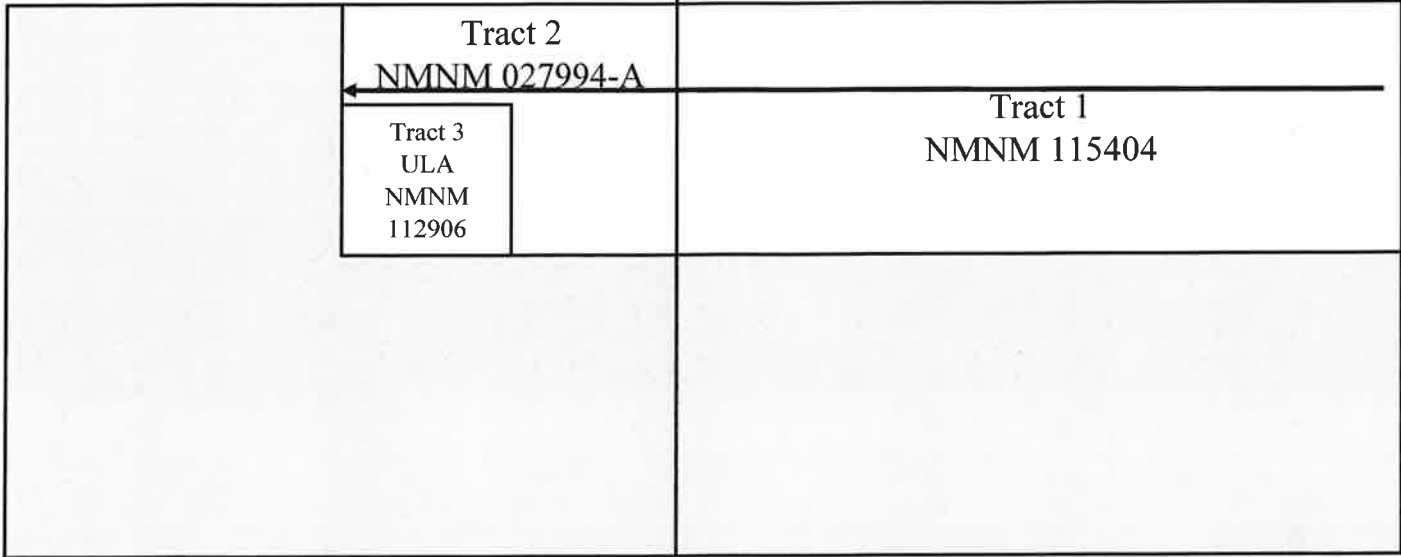

To Whom It May Concern:

Mewbourne Oil Company ("Mewbourne") as Operator, proposes to form a 960.00 acre Working Interest Unit ("WIU") covering all of the captioned Section 24, and the East half (E/2) of the captioned Section 23, for oil and gas production. Mewbourne hereby proposes to drill the captioned wells at the below referenced surface locations (SL) to the referenced bottom hole locations (BHL). The proposed wells will be drilled to a below referenced approximate true vertical depth (TVD) subsurface footage to evaluate the Wolfcamp Formation. The proposed wells will have a corresponding referenced measured depth (MD) listed below. The entire 960.00 acre unit of the captioned Sections 24 & E/2 of 23, will be dedicated to the wells as the proration units.

- Iceman "23/24" Fed Com #712H (W0AB) will have a surface location 1960' FNL & 260' FEL in the captioned Section 24 and a bottom hole location approximately 800' FNL & 2342' FEL in the captioned Section 23. We anticipate drilling to an approximate total vertical depth of 8,764' and an approximate total measured depth of 16,093'. The entire 960.00 acre unit will be dedicated to the well as the proration unit.
- Iceman "23/24" Fed Com #714H (W0HG) will have a surface location 1980' FNL & 260' FEL in the captioned Section 24 and a bottom hole location approximately 2160' FNL & 2339' FEL in the captioned Section 23. We anticipate drilling to an approximate total vertical depth of 8,747' and an approximate total measured depth of 15,982'. The entire 960.00 acre unit will be dedicated to the well as the proration unit.
- Iceman "23/24" Fed Com #716H (W0IJ) will have a surface location 2000' FNL & 260' FEL in the captioned Section 24 and a bottom hole location approximately 1760' FSL & 2337' FEL in the captioned Section 23. We anticipate drilling to an approximate total vertical depth of 8,735' and an approximate total measured depth of 16,140'. The entire 960.00 acre unit will be dedicated to the well as the proration unit.

SELF-AFFIRMED STATEMENT OF TYLER HILL

1. I am employed by Mewbourne Oil Company (“Mewbourne”) as a geologist. I am over 18 years of age, have personal knowledge of the matters addressed herein, and am competent to provide this Self-Affirmed Statement. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“Division”), and my credentials as an expert in petroleum geology matters were accepted and made a matter of record.

2. I am familiar with the geological matters that pertain to the above-referenced case.

3. **Exhibit B-1** is a general location map that depicts the Iceman 24/22 Fed Com spacing unit.

4. **Exhibit B-2** is a subsea structure map for the Wolfcamp formation that is representative of the targeted intervals. The contour intervals are 50 feet. The approximate wellbore path for the **Iceman 24/22 Fed Com #712H** well (“Well”) is depicted by a solid line. Existing producing wells in the targeted interval are represented by solid pink lines. The map demonstrates the formation is gently dipping to the east in this area. I do not observe any faulting, pinch-outs, or geologic impediments to developing the targeted intervals with horizontal wells.

5. **Exhibit B-2** also identifies three wells penetrating the targeted intervals that I used to prepare a structural cross-section from A to A’. I used these well logs because they penetrate the targeted intervals, are of good quality, and are representative of the geology in the area.

6. **Exhibit B-3** is a stratigraphic cross-section that I prepared using the logs from the representative wells shown on Exhibit B-2. Each well log on the cross-section contains gamma ray, resistivity and porosity. The proposed landing zone for the Well is labeled on the exhibit. This cross-section demonstrates that the target interval is continuous across the Unit.

7. In my opinion, a laydown orientation for the proposed Well is appropriate to properly develop the subject acreage because of an established directional pattern and the known fracture orientation in this portion of the trend.

8. Based on my geologic study of the area, the targeted interval underlying the Unit is suitable for development by horizontal wells and the tracts comprising the Unit will contribute more or less equally to the production of the Well.

9. In my opinion, the granting of Mewbourne's application will serve the interests of conservation, the protection of correlative rights, and the prevention of waste.

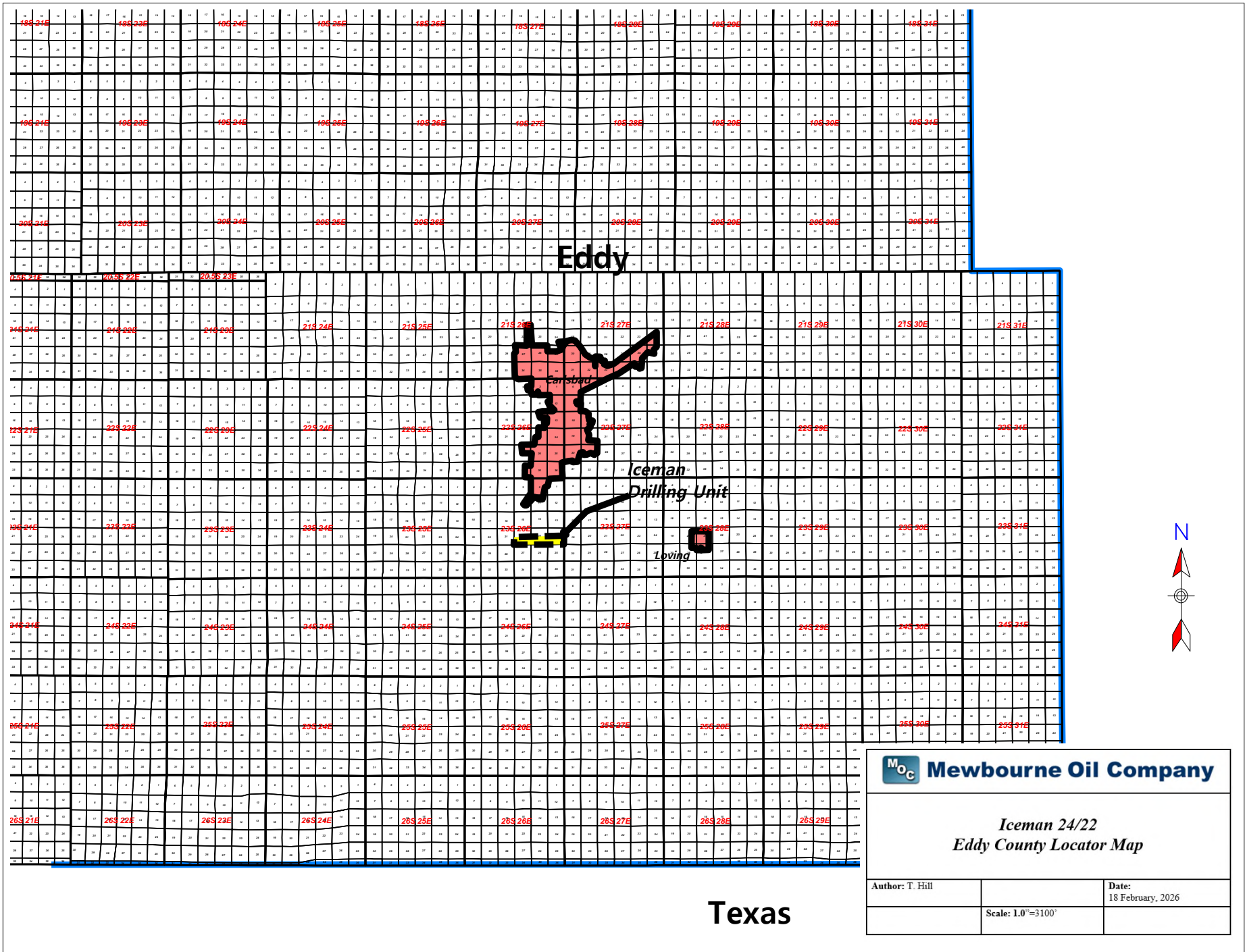
