14 March 19. This is the second regularly scheduled status conference docket, although
15 we are going to have a hearing by affidavit continuance today as well.

16 Although Freya, I don't see that as the first case I thought it was.

17 I believe it is the XTO case 25945 Hmm.

18 I printed the the docket that was emailed to me and I don't see it on here. Maybe I
19 shouldn't use this then.

20 I can give you my worksheet. That'd be great. Thank you.

21 I'm going to call case number 25945 XTO Energy.

24 Good morning, Mr. Examiner. Miguel Suazo with Beating Wozniak, appearing this
25 morning on behalf of XTO Energy.

26

27 **PH Pecos Hall 28:41**

28 Good morning, Mr. Suazo. I don't believe there's any other appearances.

29

30 **MS Miguel Suazo 28:46**

31 That's that's correct.

32

33 **PH Pecos Hall 28:48**

34 So let's get the record updated with your exhibits.

35

36 **MS Miguel Suazo 28:55**

37 Sure. So at the last hearing by affidavit, I believe the exhibits were admitted into
38 evidence and we got the amended exhibits filed. We made changes to the CPAC
39 specifically.

42 Yeah.

43 OK.

45  Miguel Suazo 29:11

46 You know the the the first part of the docket, just noting there's no other wells. And
47 then we also had some different exhibits on I think C3 and I'm not sure if there's any
48 questions for the geology witness, Mr. Kearney, but he's available for questions if the
49 technical examiner.

50 Has any?

51

52  Pecos Hall 29:31

53 Thank you, Mr. Suazo. The exhibits were received. They are accepted into evidence.

54 The case was reviewed and it's taken under advisement.

55

57 Great. Thank you.

58

59  Pecos Hall 29:42

60 All right, have a good day. Let's go on to.

61

62  Miguel Suazo 29:43

63 You too.

64

65  Pecos Hall 29:46

66 I want to go on. I want to call a case out of order here. It's a case I was sent an e-mail
67 about yesterday. Give me one second. This is case number 25727.

68 It is a Spur Energy case. We received a motion for continuance on this case to delay it
69 a few more months. Inches of appearance, please. Yes, Mr. Examiner Dana Hardy on
70 behalf of Spur. OK, thank you.

71 Thank you. And are there any other parties that you know of? Mr. Padilla represents a

72 party that had protested and so this had been set for a contested hearing, but then
73 they withdrew their protest. So he's still entered in the case, but they are not
74 objecting. Thank you, Miss Hardy. So if I'm not mistaken this case.
75 Was filed in October.
76 That's correct. OK. And you're requesting moving it to May. Why? Because SPUR
77 needs additional time to prepare their exhibits for hearing subsequent to the
78 contested hearing being vacated.
79 It's too, too far for us. It's too far in the future for us. Why are they not prepared for
80 March 26th? That's still, that's still over a week away from that because they were
81 going to, well, the deadline would be today, right, for the exhibits for next week and
82 they were planning to send.
83 And ratification agreements to the overrides because the overriding royalty interests
84 were noticed of the case, but they have not received ratification agreements. So that
85 is why SPUR wanted to continue the case so it would have time to do that.
86 I can't keep it on the docket that long. I don't know. I don't understand why.
87 That wasn't done before when we had a contested hearing set for this case. We did
88 move it on your request to March 26, right? Because this was the that that was the
89 next docket available, yes, after the contested hearing. That's right.
90 That's right.
91 I can put it on an April docket, but I can't go to May. That would be fine. April would
92 be fine. Freya, what's the first April docket we can put this case on? We don't have a
93 hearing by affidavit docket in April. Any docket will do. It doesn't have to be hearing
94 by for the status conference docket on the 16th and two special.
95 Buckets one on the 21st and one on the 28th. The 16th is fine if you want to. If you
96 want to continue it, Freya to the 16th, we were going to reject the continue. OK, so
97 but I'm gonna.
98 I'm going to make that exception and we'll get it on the April 16th docket. It'll be the
99 first case that we hear on that docket. I expect it's going to be a simple case.
100 The only reason that we wouldn't do that is if we don't have a technical examiner, but
101 I think someone can fill in. OK, thank you very much. Appreciate it. You're welcome.
102 That works. So Freya, would you accept the continuance to the 16th? Yes. And would
103 you send an e-mail to John Garcia and see who might?
104 Attend just that very first case. Yes, I will. Thank you, Fran. All right, we're off the
105 record. In that case, let's move on to Mewborn Oil. This is 25746. Good morning.
106 Dana Hardy on behalf of Mewborn. Thank you.

108 **D Deana** 33:27

109 Good morning, everyone. Dina Bennett on behalf of Avant operating to and Avant
110 objected to the case moving forward by affidavit.

111

112 **PH Pecos Hall** 33:34

113 Perfect. Thank you, Miss Bennett. And are you maintaining your objection?

114

115 **D Deana** 33:38

116 At the moment, yes, the parties are working through an agreement which will
117 hopefully obviate Avon's objection.

118

119 **PH Pecos Hall** 33:46

120 Makes sense. Thank you. Good morning, Mr. Examiner. Carrie Hatley, entering her
121 appearance on behalf of Marathon Oil Permian and we're monitoring only. All right,
122 very good. So, Miss Hardy, it sounds like negotiations are ongoing. How do you want
123 to proceed? Negotiations are ongoing and are making progress. We would propose
124 to set this case for a status conference.

125 Again on April 16th, OK, because we're up cautiously optimistic that an agreement
126 can be reached by then. Now this case looks like it's a little old. It was filed in
127 December.

128 December, Yes, 25746. That's funny 'cause the other 257 number we had was from
129 October. Let me just quickly verify how old the case is.

130 I showed it was filed on December 23rd. Oh, so you know. All right. December 23rd.

131 Yes. Thank you.

132 OK. This would be the last status conference. That's fine, understood. And we've sent
133 out some dates. I think you probably know what they are for contested hearings. So
134 if for some reason we come back on the 16th and.

135 And and and Miss Bennett has not withdrawn her objection. Please be prepared for a
136 May contested hearing. Understood.

137 Test here. All right. Thank you. We're off the record. I should ask Miss Bennett. Is
138 there anything further?

141 No, thank you very much.

143 **PH Pecos Hall** 35:27

144 All right. Thank you, Miss Hardy. All right. Moving on to Milestone Environmental
145 25801. Dana Hardy on behalf of Milestone. Thank you. Carrie Hatley on behalf of
146 CMG Operating. And we objected to this. Oh, you did. We did. Why did you object?
147 Well, we have some concerns about the application, but we're working it out with
148 Milestone. We think we can reach an agreement potentially even today. It's we
149 believe that a solution is imminent. We're very hopeful. What's the Miss Hardy?
150 What's the nature of this application?

151 It is an application to change the injection rate for a disposal well, and you have wells
152 in the area. We do, I thought.

153 on April 16th. Perfect.

154 OK. Or a dismissal of the, well, you wouldn't dismiss the application, would you?

155 Right. We wouldn't dismiss. Assuming we reach an agreement by then, we would let
156 the division know and then hopefully we could present by affidavit on the May
157 docket or the soonest docket after that.

158 OK. Sounds good. Thank you, Miss Hardy. Thank you. OK, we're off the record. In that
159 case, let's go on to #4 on the docket. This is a Mewborn oil case. It looks like it's a
160 few cases together, 2586025862 and 63.

163 Good morning, Mr. Hearing Examiner, Paul Vance with the Santa Fe Office of Holland
164 and Hart on behalf of the applicant, Mewburn Oil Company.

167 Good morning, Miss Vance.

168

169 **D Deana** 37:14

170 Good morning, Mr. Examiner, Dina Bennett with Model Sperling on behalf of Paloma
171 Permian Asset Co. And we did object to these cases moving forward by affidavit.

172

173 **PH Pecos Hall** 37:22

174 And what's the status of your objection now?

175

176 **D Deana** 37:25

177 We are still objecting. Paloma Permian does not intend to, at least at this point, file
178 competing applications. There's just a lot of moving parts and Paloma Permian wants
179 to make sure it can preserve its rights.

185 OK, perfect. Thanks, Miss Bennett. Mr. Examiner, Dana Hardy with Hardy McLean on
186 behalf of Permian Resources operating. And we did also object to these applications,
187 but don't anticipate at this point filing competing applications and what's the status
188 of your negotiations?

194 It's my understanding there are negotiations going on between multiple parties for
195 this acreage. So we would be fine, I think with another status conference. I think
196 there's progress being made on negotiations, hopefully, OK.

203 Good morning. Good morning, Mr. Hearing Examiner, Darren Savage with Avenue
204 and Schill appearing on behalf of WPX Energy Permian LLC. And we did object to to
205 this case. We are, we have done a number of negotiations and offers and we think
206 it's very promising.

212 To reach a potential resolution. As precaution, we did file competing applications, so
213 they are in the system. Do you know the numbers by any chance? Yes, 25049
214 through.

215 I'm sorry, 26049 through 26052. Perfect. Thank you, Mr. All right, Mr. Savage. So we
216 have competing applications, Miss Vance.

217

219 Yeah.

220

221 **PV Paula M. Vance** 39:01

222 Sorry. Yeah. My understanding is that the parties are negotiating, just speaking to
223 every all of the other attorneys that have weighed in. We would ask for another
224 status conference to hopefully maybe resolve some of the issues.

225 And just give the parties additional time to work things out. We've only these were
226 filed in December and we've sort of had an initial objection then we had one status
227 conference.

228 I believe we've only had one status conference and I was trying to look at the date
229 for that and that's when we heard that WPX was gonna object or file competing
230 applications and then.

231 Most recently with Paloma filing their entry of appearance and objection. So again,
232 there's lots of parties here. We would ask for another status conference so that the
233 parties can have additional time to negotiate.

236 Let me understand the competing applications a little bit better. Miss Vance, have
237 you? I'll come to you, Mr. Savage, if necessary. But Miss Vance, what is the
238 overlapping acreage in these competing applications?

239

240 **PV Paula M. Vance** 40:17

241 I have not looked at those competing applications. I that's the first time I've gotten
242 the case numbers, so I would have to look and see what it is.

243

244 **PH Pecos Hall** 40:24

245 OK, let me ask Mr. Savage. Yes, we we followed those yesterday.

246 So the the the overlapping unit, the overlapping acreage, so.

247 Excuse me, I get my my thoughts here. So Mewburn originally filed applications for
248 an original development plan that was 2 1/2 mile wells and that was October 4th and
249 that's when we entered negotiations and tried to, you know, start working towards
250 resolving.

251 These matters in response, Uburn then filed dismissed those applications and filed
252 these new applications December 9th.

253 The new applications are quite a different venture. There are it's a four mile well
254 that covers 272829 and 30 and and and and MU brains proposing for example units
255 of the size of.

256 2500 something acres. So you know we're we're very hopeful that so we we follow
257 our our our interests are in developing two of the sections 28 and 29 and we're
258 hoping that.

259 We could reach a resolution where that could be accommodated where both parties
260 could develop their two mile or 2 1/2 mile wells. That's that's really what we're
261 shooting for and and and to be clear in your in your acreage what is do you know
262 what your ownership interest is.

263 You know, I don't know exactly, but but it's a strong, it's a strong presence and Miss
264 Vance at the last status conference which was in February, I said that if they that.
265 That I knew that WPX intended to file competing applications. I said that I would set
266 a contested hearing if the status if your negotiations had not been complete by now.
267 So we need to get something set.

268 We can't just keep these on the docket, especially now that we have competing
269 applications. We can set it for May for two months from now, which should give you
270 plenty of time to finish or to come to a hearing. But I'm not willing to go past May.
271 Freya, you sent out dates, didn't you?

272 I did. What was the date in May?

273 It was May 26th, which is the day after Memorial Day. OK, we could also do May
274 27th, 28th. So Miss Vance, we have May 26th, 27 or 28.

275

276 **PV** **Paula M. Vance** 43:11

277 Well, I would take the May 28th. I know I'm not taking the 27th because that's my
278 birthday. So and yeah, well, I come from a very strong household of Geminis. Both of
279 my parents are Gemini and my husband is a Gemini too.

280

281 **PH** **Pecos Hall** 43:15

282 I forgot that we're both Geminis, yeah.

283 Wow. Wow. Okay.

284

285 **PV** **Paula M. Vance** 43:28

286 Yeah, don't don't **** us off. So yeah, I'll take the the May 28th if that works.

287

288 **PH** **Pecos Hall** 43:35

289 Sounds good. Okay.

290 OK, it does work for us, Mr. Savage. Yeah, that we would agree to that. So Freya,
291 would you issue a pre-hearing order for the competing cases and would you join
292 26049 through 5/2 with Miss Vance's cases?

293 Yes. All right. Very good. And I know that Miss Bennett and Miss Hardy have not filed
294 competing cases. Would you be participating in the contested hearing if there is
295 one?

296 We would be entering our appearance and maintaining our protection of right and
297 Miss Bennett.

298

300 That is the same as well.

301

302 **PH** **Pecos Hall** 44:18

303 Very good. OK. All right. Very good. So neither of you would have witnesses then. I
304 would need to confirm, but I I don't think so. But I'm not absolutely certain. If we did,
305 I don't think it would be, you know, several witnesses. Right. Yeah. OK. All right.
306 Anything else, Miss Bennett?

307

309 No, nothing for me. Thank you.

312 Miss Hardy? No, thank you. All right, Miss Vance.

318 All right, Mr. Savage. Yeah, thank you. All right, we're off the record in those cases.

319 Thank you. Let's move on to Matador production. Looks like we have 3 no 4 cases

320 here, 259121314 and 1/5.

323 Good morning, Mr. Hearing Examiner Paula Vance with the Santa Fe Office of

324 Holland and Hart on behalf of Matador.

325

326 **PH Pecos Hall** 45:02

327 Thank you.

328

329 **D Deana** 45:03

330 Good morning everyone. Dena Bennett from Model Sperling on behalf of Avant

331 operating to and we did object to these these cases moving forward by affidavit.

332

333 **PH Pecos Hall** 45:12

334 Thank you. What's the status of your objection?

335

336 **D Deana** 45:14

337 We Avant is maintaining its objection. Avant does own quite a bit of acreage in

338 MRCS or Matador's proposed unit, and Avant is hopeful that there could be some

339 negotiations that occur, but at the moment Avant.

340 Is considering sending out its own proposal letters and then if it has to file

341 competing applications. So they and I I coordinated with Miss Vance or Miss Vance

342 actually coordinated with me yesterday and we were both amenable to.

343 Requesting a status conference in April. At that point we would know more about the

344 next steps.

345

346 **PH Pecos Hall** 45:56

347 That's fine, Miss Vance. They're your cases. Is that how you want to proceed?

348

349 **PV Paula M. Vance** 46:01

350 Yes, we would like another status conference to give some more time for the parties

351 to negotiate. And just for the record, the the applicant and this is actually Greyhound
352 Resources LLC.

353

354 **PH Pecos Hall** 46:14

355 Oh, oh, so not Matador.

356 OK.

357

358 **PV Paula M. Vance** 46:32

359 Just wanted to be clear for the record.

360

361 **PH Pecos Hall** 46:32

362 OK.

363 But but you're not saying that we should change on our docket Matador to
364 Greyhound? No. OK, alright, sounds good. So the status conference in April will be
365 the final status conference. By that point, I'll expect that you guys know where these
366 cases are going and if you're going to file a competing application, you'll you'll have
367 the dates for that.

417 Sorry, I was muted. I said. Um, I actually withdrew from the cases and Miss Luck has
418 entered her appearance in my in my place.

427 Very good. We need to update this, but yes, I know that Freya said Miss Luck would

431 Good morning, Mr. Hang Examiner, Caitlin Locke, appearing for a bond operating in
432 these two pieces.

447 entering her parents on behalf of Marathon Oil Permian and we are monitoring only.

454 So who objected?

457 Philip White. I am here. Philip White.

458

460 Miss Luck, who objected?

461 I I don't even know who that is.

462

464 Well, I own 130 unleashed mineral acres in this project.

465

466 **PH Pecos Hall** 48:45

467 OK, so you've objected on what basis?

468

469 **+15*****79** 48:50

470 On on the basis that I've been in the hospital and I haven't had time to prepare any
471 kind of presentation for the for the Commissioner.

472

473 **PH Pecos Hall** 49:06

474 This isn't in front of the Commission, Mr. White. It's in front of the division at this
475 point and basically.

476 It's a compulsory pooling application. What problem do you have with the
477 application?

478

480 Well, I've I've sent 2 detailed explanations of my problems, but the main one is I have
481 unleashed a 40 acre track that that their proposed location will prevent me from
482 drilling a vertical.

483 Called third bone spring well on.

486 OK. All right, Mr. White, are you going to get an attorney?

487

489 You know, I I guess I should, but I I like I say I've been in the hospital. This has all hit

494 represents Paloma or Avant, excuse me, and Avant has a due process right to a

547 in front of the examiner in a forced boeing.

550 OK. I understand your position. I appreciate it. We're going to issue a pre-hearing
551 order for April 28 and you can continue your negotiations. If for some reason you
552 come to an agreement, we'll deal with that at the time, but I would suggest that you
