SECOND AMENDED APPLICATION

Mewbourne Oil Company (“Mewbourne” or “Applicant”) (OGRID No. 14744), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division pursuant to the provisions of NMSA 1978, § 70-2-17, for an order pooling all uncommitted mineral owners in a standard 1,299.51-acre, more or less, well spacing unit in the Wolfcamp formation underlying Lots 1-4, S/2 N/2 and S/2 (All equivalent) of irregular Sections 3 and 4, Township 22 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. In support of its application, Mewbourne states:

1. Applicant is a working interest owner in the proposed horizontal spacing unit and has the right to drill thereon.
2. Mewbourne seeks to dedicate the above-referenced spacing unit to the proposed **Guyana Buffalo 4/3 Federal Com 716H** and **Guyana Buffalo 4/3 Federal Com 855H** wells, both to be drilled from surface locations in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of irregular Section 4, to bottomhole locations in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of irregular Section 3; and **Guyana Buffalo 4/3 Federal Com 718H** and **Guyana Buffalo 4/3 Federal Com 857H** wells, both to be drilled from surface locations in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of irregular Section 4, to bottomhole locations in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of irregular Section 3.
3. The completed interval of the **Guyana Buffalo 4/3 Federal Com 855H** is expected to remain within 330 feet of the adjoining quarter-quarter section (or equivalent) tracts to allow

inclusion of these proximity tracts within the proposed horizontal spacing unit under 19.15.16.15.B(3)(b) NMAC.

4. This amended application corrects the well numbers in the original filing for the **Guyana Buffalo 4/3 Federal Com 855H** and **Guyana Buffalo 4/3 Federal Com 857H**, which were previously listed as the **Guyana Buffalo 4/3 Federal Com 825H** and **Guyana Buffalo 4/3 Federal Com 827H**.

5. Additionally, based on the agreement reached with Permian Resources Operating, LLC, Mewbourne has revised its spacing and dedicated acreage for this application, which now includes all of irregular Sections 3 and 4. Mewbourne plans to drill infill wells in the N/2 of the spacing unit in 2027.

6. Applicant has sought and been unable to obtain voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from all mineral interest owners in the subject spacing unit.

7. The pooling of interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste, and will protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on May 7, 2026, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order:

- A. Pooling all uncommitted interest owners in the horizontal spacing unit;
- B. Designating Applicant as operator of this spacing unit and the horizontal wells to be drilled thereon;
- C. Authorizing Applicant to recover its costs of drilling, completing, and equipping the wells;

- D. Approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedures; and
- E. Imposing a 200% charge for the risk assumed by Applicant in drilling and completing the wells against any working interest owner who does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of the wells.

**SELF-AFFIRMED STATEMENT OF ADRIANA JIMENEZ-SALGADO**

1. My name is Adriana Jimenez-Salgado. I work for Mewbourne Oil Company (“Mewbourne”) as a Landman.

2. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“Division”) as an expert witness in petroleum land matters. My credentials as a petroleum landman have been accepted by the Division and made a matter of record.

3. I am familiar with the application filed by Mewbourne in this case, and I am familiar with the status of the lands in the subject area.

4. None of the uncommitted parties in this case have indicated opposition to proceeding by self-affirmed statement and, therefore, I do not expect any opposition at the hearing.

5. Mewbourne seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interest owners in a standard 1,279.56-acre, more or less, well spacing unit in the Wolfcamp formation underlying Lots 1-4, S/2 N/2 and S/2 (All equivalent) of irregular Sections 3 and 4, Township 22 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

6. Mewbourne seeks to initially dedicate the above-referenced spacing unit to the proposed **Guyana Buffalo 4/3 Federal Com 716H** and **Guyana Buffalo 4/3 Federal Com 855H** wells, both to be drilled from surface locations in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of irregular Section 4, to bottomhole locations in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of irregular Section 3; and **Guyana Buffalo 4/3**

7. The completed interval of the **Guyana Buffalo 4/3 Federal Com 855H** is expected to remain within 330 feet of the adjoining quarter-quarter section (or equivalent) tracts to allow inclusion of these proximity tracts within the proposed horizontal spacing unit under 19.15.16.15.B(3)(b) NMAC.

8. Based on the agreement reached with Permian Resources Operating, LLC, Mewbourne has revised its spacing and dedicated acreage for this application, which now includes all of irregular Sections 3 and 4. Mewbourne plans to drill infill wells in the N/2 of the spacing unit in 2027.

9. **Mewbourne Exhibit C-1** contains a draft Form C-102 for the proposed wells. The form demonstrates that the completed first and last take points for the wells will be at a non-standard location. Mewbourne plans to file separate administrative applications for non-standard well location approval. The exhibit shows that the wells will be assigned to the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp (gas) [98220].

10. **Mewbourne Exhibit C-2** identifies the tracts of land comprising the horizontal spacing unit, the ownership interests in each tract, and ownership interests on a spacing unit basis. The parties Mewbourne seeks to pool are highlighted in yellow. The exhibit also includes the commitment status and, if applicable, type of commitment for each interest owner.

11. **Mewbourne Exhibit C-3** contains a sample of the well proposal letter and AFEs sent to owners with a working interest. The costs reflected in the AFEs are consistent with what

Mewbourne and other operators have incurred for drilling similar horizontal wells in the area in this formation.

12. Mewbourne requests that the overhead and administrative costs for drilling and producing the proposed wells be set at \$10,000 per month while drilling and \$1,000 per month while producing. These costs are consistent with what other operators are charging in this area for similar wells.

13. **Mewbourne Exhibit C-4** contains a general summary of the contacts with the uncommitted interest owners. As indicated in the exhibit, Mewbourne has made a good faith effort to locate and has had communications with all of the parties that it seeks to pool in this case in an effort to reach voluntary joinder. In my opinion, Mewbourne has undertaken good faith efforts to reach an agreement with the uncommitted interest owners.

14. Mewbourne has provided the law firm of Holland & Hart LLP with the names and addresses of the parties that Mewbourne seeks to pool and instructed that they be notified of this hearing. Mewbourne has conducted a diligent search of all public records in the county where the property is located, reviewed telephone directories, and conducted computer searches to locate contact information for each interest owner.

15. **Mewbourne Exhibits C-1 through C-4** were either prepared by me or compiled under my direction and supervision.

16. I affirm under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of New Mexico that the foregoing statements are true and correct. I understand that this self-affirmed statement will be used as written testimony in this case. This statement is made on the date next to my signature below.

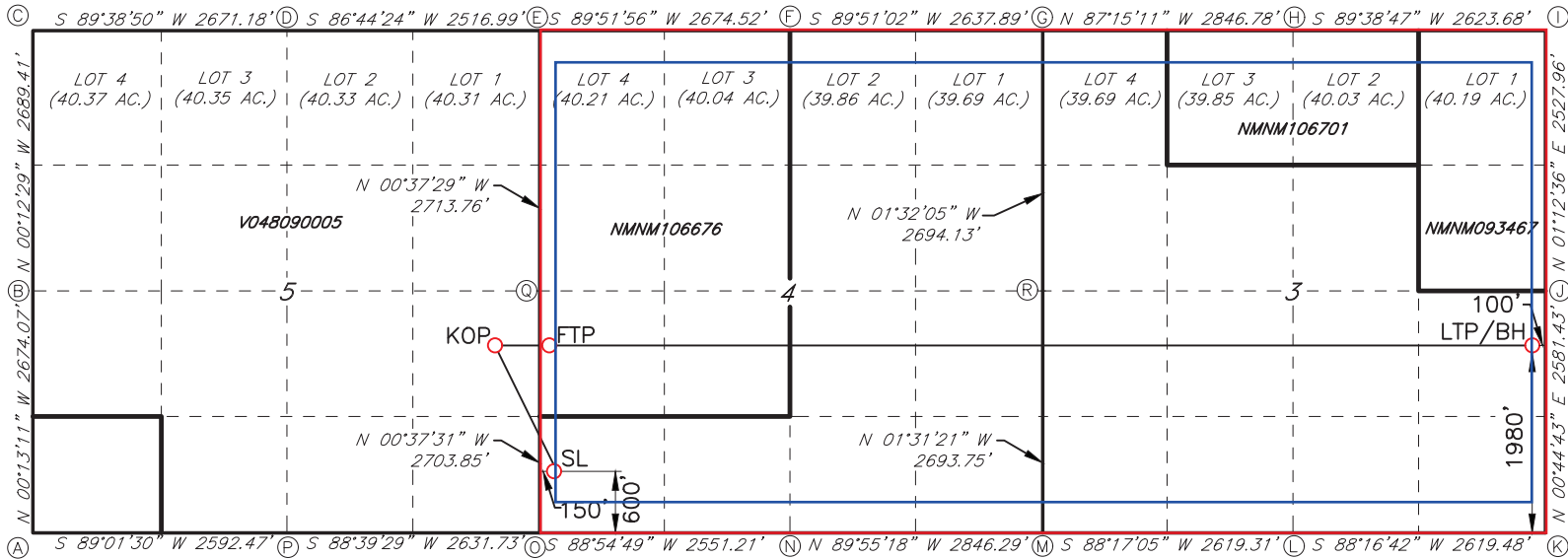


ACREAGE DEDICATION PLATS

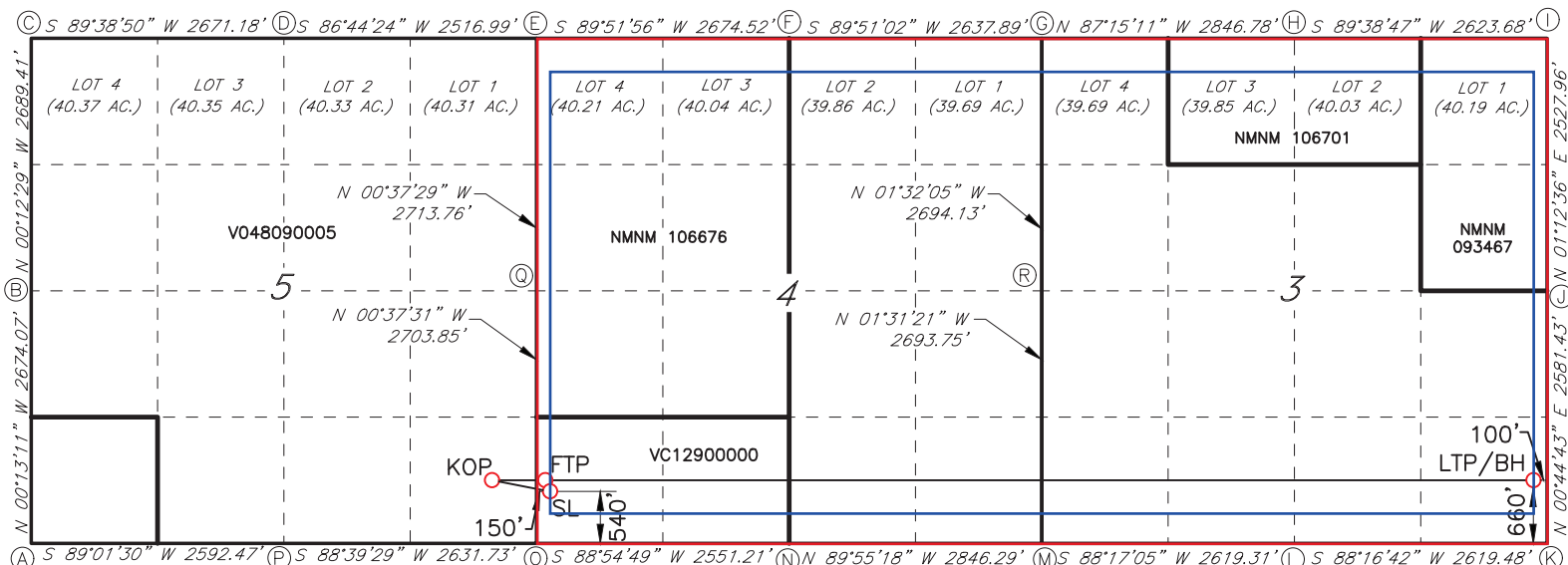


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GUYANA BUFFALO 4/3 FED COM #718H

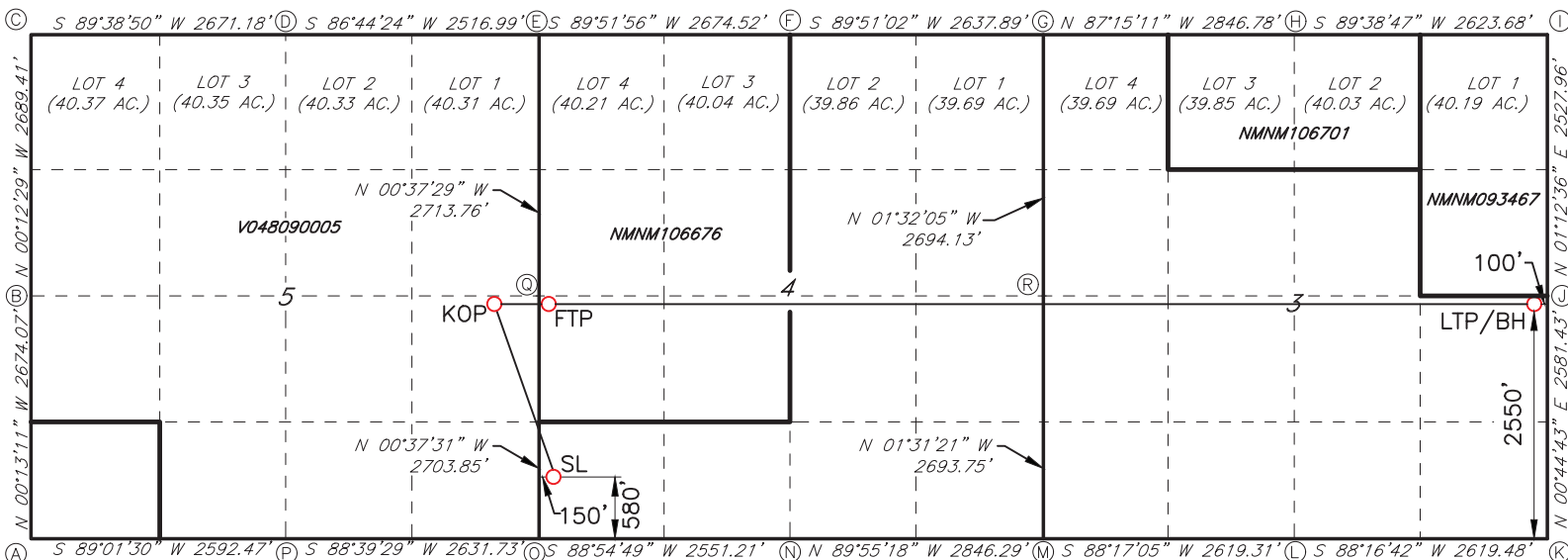

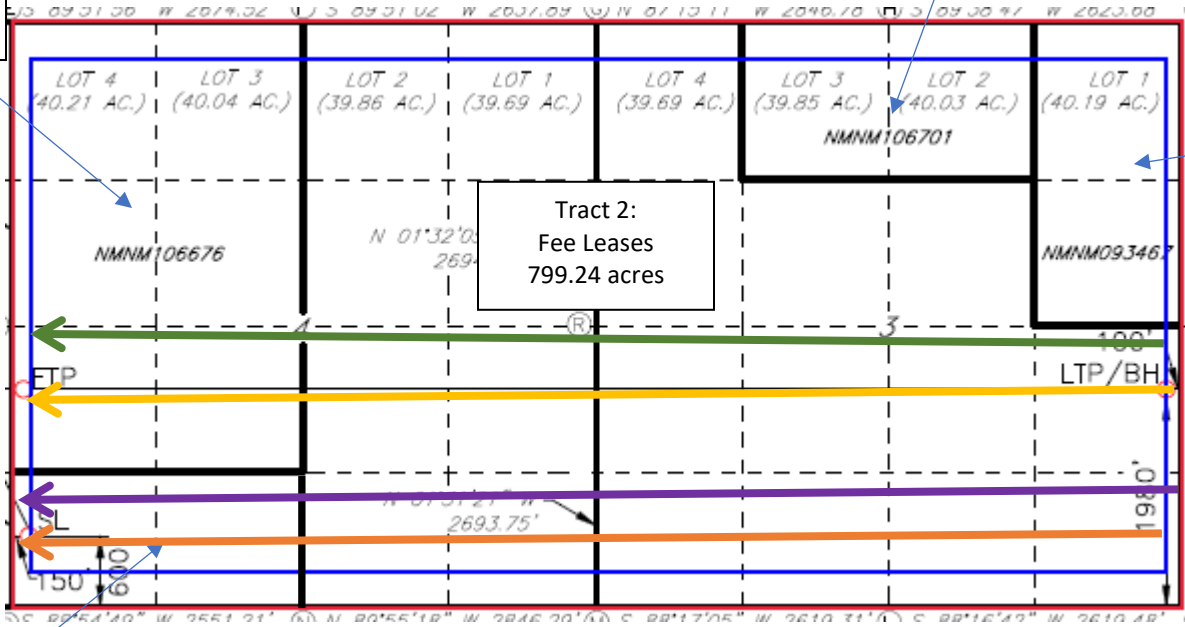

**SELF-AFFIRMED STATEMENT OF JESSE HENSLEY**

1. My name is Jesse Hensley. I work for Mewbourne Oil Company ("Mewbourne") as a Geologist.
2. I have not previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") as an expert witness in petroleum geology matters. I have included a copy of my resume as **Mewbourne Exhibit D-1** for the Division to review and respectfully request that my credentials be accepted as a matter of record, and I be tendered as an expert in geological matters.
3. I am familiar with the application filed by Mewbourne in this case, and I have conducted a geologic study of the lands in the subject area. Mewbourne is targeting the Wolfcamp formation in this case.
4. **Mewbourne Exhibit D-2** is a general locator map.
5. **Mewbourne Exhibit D-3** is a subsea structure map that I prepared for the Wolfcamp. The contour intervals are 100 feet. The area comprising the proposed spacing unit is outlined in red with the approximate location and orientation of the initial wells noted with dashed lines color-coded by formation. The structure map shows the targeted formation gently dipping to the east. The structure appears consistent across the proposed spacing unit, and I do not observe any faulting, pinch outs, or other geologic impediments to drilling horizontal wells.
6. Mewbourne Exhibit D-3 also shows a line of cross-section through the proposed horizontal spacing unit from A to A'. I chose the logs from these wells to create the cross-section because they penetrate the targeted interval, are of good quality and have been subjected to petrophysical analysis of the targeted interval. In my opinion, these well logs are representative of the geology in the subject area.

7. **Mewbourne Exhibit D-4** is a stratigraphic cross-section that I prepared using the logs from the representative wells shown in Mewbourne Exhibit D-3. Each well on the cross-section contains gamma ray, resistivity, and porosity logs. The target interval for the proposed wells is marked on the cross-section with a dashed red line. The cross-section demonstrates that the targeted interval is continuous across the proposed spacing unit.


8. In my opinion, laydown orientation of the proposed wells is the appropriate orientation for horizontal well development in this area.

9. Based on my geologic study, the Wolfcamp formation underlying the subject area is suitable for development by horizontal wells and the acreage comprising the proposed spacing unit will contribute more-or-less equally to the production from the wellbores. I have not identified any geologic impediments to drilling horizontal wells in the area of the spacing unit proposed.

10. In my opinion, horizontal drilling will be the most efficient method to develop this acreage, to prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, and to result in the greatest ultimate recovery, and that approving Mewbourne's application will be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste, and protection of correlative rights.

11. **Mewbourne Exhibits D-1 through D-4** were either prepared by me or compiled under my direction and supervision.
