REPLY TO MOTION TO DISMISS

Permian Resources Operating, LLC (“Permian”) hereby submits this reply to American Energy Resources, LLC’s (“AER”) response to Permian’s Motion to Dismiss “Application for Reopening and Motion Requesting Joinder of Claims.” Permian’s Motion should be granted for at least the following three reasons:

1. First, Jonathan Samaniego argues, without citing authority, that notice for the underlying cases was insufficient because notice was not actually received. However, the rule governing notice requires only that notice be provided by certified mail, return receipt requested, to the address of record or known to the applicant at the time the applicant filed the application; Permian is not required to prove notice was actually received by AER or Jonathan Samaniego. *See* 19.15.4.12.A(1)(a) NMAC and 19.15.4.12.C(3). Permian has demonstrated it complied with this requirement and that it also has provided constructive notice to Jonathan Samaniego pursuant to 19.15.4.12.B NMAC, as addressed below. Tellingly, Jonathan Samaniego does not dispute that the addresses used for the notice sent to him by certified mail were incorrect. Based on Permian’s record review, dating back to March 2023, the address of Jonathan Samaniego/AER is listed as P.O. Box

114, Hagerman, NM 88232 in every document filed of record in the Eddy County Clerk's Office. Thus, the thing Jonathan Samaniego complains of is the very thing that he potentially perpetuates through his own actions by not providing an updated or valid mailing address to the extent he contends the address was incorrect, which he does not.

2. Second, in Case No. 25137 the landman (Collin Christian) provided a self-affirmed statement attesting to the diligent search Permian conducted to find the last known address(es) for each affected party, including Jonathan Samaniego. See **Exhibit A**. Multiple addresses were found of record for Jonathan Samaniego at the time the application was filed. Notably, Jonathan Samaniego does not dispute that any of them are incorrect. Thus, Permian made multiple attempts to make contact at various addresses of record with Jonathan Samaniego directly through certified mailings, which were all returned to sender. However, after "exercising reasonable diligence," Permian also included Jonathan Samaniego on its notice of publication, which was timely published prior to the hearing. See **Exhibit B**; see also, 19.15.4.12.B NMAC. The case was taken under advisement, and the Division issued Order No. R-23748 on April 1, 2025. No party filed a *de novo* application within 30 days of the Division issuing Order No. R-23748.

3. Lastly, as to the other cases, as previously stated in Permian's motion to dismiss, even if AER/Jonathan Samaniego acquired an interest in any of the matters listed in its filing after the orders were issued, the interest would be taken subject to the pooling orders.

WHEREFORE, Permian respectfully requests that American Energy Resources, LLC's "Application for Reopening and Motion Requesting Joinder of Claims" be dismissed by the Division.

SELF-AFFIRMED STATEMENT OF COLLIN CHRISTIAN

1. My name is Collin Christian. I work for Permian Resources Operating, LLC (“Permian”) as a Landman.

2. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“Division”) as an expert witness in petroleum land matters. My credentials as a petroleum landman have been accepted by the Division and made a matter of record.

3. I am familiar with the applications filed by Permian in this case, and I am familiar with the status of the lands in the subject area.

4. In Case No. 25137, Permian seeks to pool the uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying a standard 640-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit comprised of the S/2 of irregular Sections 1 and 2, Township 22 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico and initially dedicate the unit to the proposed **Water Buffalo #133H** well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of irregular Section 3, with a first take point in the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of irregular Section 2, and a last take point in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of irregular Section 1.

5. This form demonstrates that the completed interval for the well is expected to remain within 330 feet of the adjoining quarter-quarter section (or equivalent) tracts to allow

inclusion of these proximity tracts within the proposed horizontal spacing units under 19.15.16.15.B(1)(b) NMAC.

6. **Permian Exhibit C-1** contains a C-102 for the proposed well. This form demonstrates that the completed interval for the well will comply with statewide setbacks for oil wells. The exhibit shows that the well will be assigned to the Esperanza; Bone Spring [97755].

7. **Permian Exhibit C-2** identifies the tracts of land comprising the horizontal spacing unit, the ownership interests in each tract, and a recapitulation of the ownership. The interest owners that Permian seeks to pool are highlighted in yellow. Permian Exhibit C-2 also includes unleased mineral interest and record title interest that Permian seeks to pool. The subject acreage is comprised of fee lands.

8. **Permian Exhibit C-3** contains a sample of the well proposal letter and AFE for the well that was sent to owners with a working interest. The costs reflected in the AFE are consistent with what Permian and other operators have incurred for drilling similar horizontal wells in the area in this formation.

9. Permian requests that the overhead and administrative costs for drilling and producing the proposed well be set at \$10,000 per month while drilling and \$1,000 per month while producing. These costs are consistent with what other operators are charging in this area for similar wells.

10. **Permian Exhibit C-4** contains a general summary of the contacts with the uncommitted interest owners. As indicated in the exhibit, Permian has made a good faith effort to locate and has had communications with the majority of the parties that it seeks to pool in this case in an effort to reach voluntary joinder. In my opinion, Permian has undertaken good faith efforts to reach an agreement with the uncommitted interest owners.

11. Permian has provided the law firm of Holland & Hart LLP with the names and addresses of the parties that Permian seeks to pool and instructed that they be notified of this hearing. Permian has conducted a diligent search of all public records in the county where the property is located, reviewed telephone directories, and conducted computer searches to locate contact information for each interest owner.

12. Permian Exhibits C-1 through C-4 were either prepared by me or compiled under my direction and supervision.

13. I affirm under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of New Mexico that the foregoing statements are true and correct. I understand that this self-affirmed statement will be used as written testimony in this case. This statement is made on the date next to my signature below.

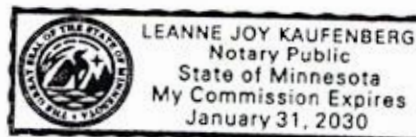
