APPLICANT’S STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Under **Case No. 26116**, Permian seeks to extend the drilling deadline under compulsory pooling Order No. R-23221, as amended (“Pooling Order”). On May 30, 2024, the Division entered Order No. R-23221 in Case No. 24343, which pooled the uncommitted interests underlying a 640-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation (Esperanza; Bone Spring [97755]) comprised of the N/2 of Section 7, Township 22 South, Range 27 East, and the N/2 of Section 12, Township 22 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico

(the “Unit”). SPC Resources, LLC was designated as operator and Order No. R-23221 dedicates the Unit to the proposed initial **Caveman 132H** (API No.30-015-55667) (formerly the Hanna 131H) well.

Subsequently, on July 24, 2025 the Division issued Order R-23221-A in Case No. 25415 amending the Order to designate Permian as operator of the Unit and the initial well and to extend the deadline to commence drilling.

Good cause exists to extend the deadline to commence drilling the initial well under the Pooling Order, as amended.
