APPLICATION

Permian Resources Operating, LLC (“Permian Resources” or “Applicant”) files this application with the Oil Conservation Division (“Division”) requesting a one-year extension of time to commence drilling operations under Order No. R-23982 (“Order”). In support of this application, Permian Resources states the following.

1. The Division entered the Order in Case No. 25503 on September 2, 2025.
2. The Order pooled all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation, underlying a 319.88-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit, comprised of the S/2 N/2 of Section 24, Township 20 South, Range 26 East, and the S/2 N/2 equivalent of irregular Section 19, Township 20 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico (“Unit”). The Order further dedicated the Unit to the Le Mans 2419 State Com 132H well (“Well”).
3. The Order designated Permian Resources (OGRID No. 372165) as operator of the Unit and the Well.
4. The Order requires Applicant to commence drilling the Well within one (1) year of the date of the Order unless Applicant obtains a time extension from the Division Director for good cause shown.
5. Applicant requests a one-year extension of time to commence drilling the Well so that it

can incorporate the Well into a co-development with Permian Resources' offsetting Catalina unit. This approach supports improved parent-child production and therefore, prevents waste and protects correlative rights.

6. Accordingly, Applicant requests that the Division extend the deadline to commence drilling the Well until September 2, 2027.

7. Good cause exists for the requested extension.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that the Division extend the deadline to commence drilling the Well under the Order until September 2, 2027.
