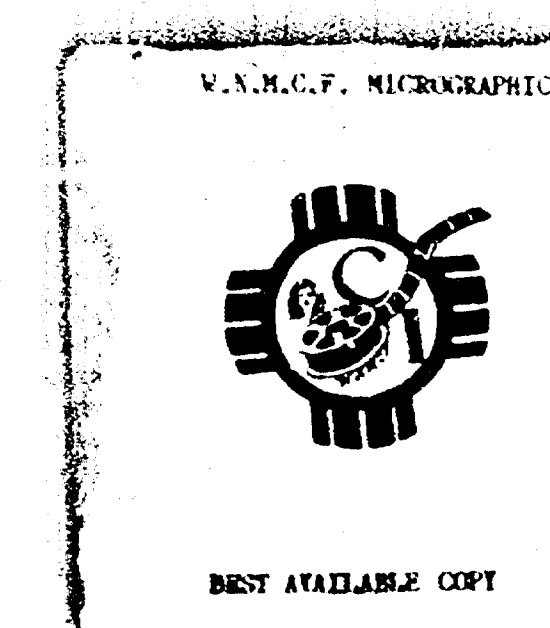
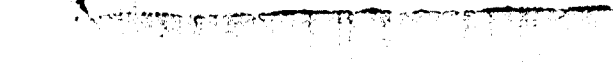

CASE 631: Application of Hagan Petroleum Corporation for special pool rules, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-stated case, seeks the promulgation of special pool rules for the Hagan-Wallace gas pool which is situated on the northeast corner of Section 11, Township 14 South, Range 21 East, 100N. In the absence of objection, this pool will be placed on the standard 120-acre spacing for Hagan-Wallace gas pools unless the present 120-acre spacing.

CASE 632: Application of McChallen Oil Corporation for an unorthodox gas well location, Chaves County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-stated case, seeks approval for the unorthodox location of its Federal Well No. 2, located 2100 feet from the North and East lines of Section 11, Township 14 South, Range 20 East, 100N. McChallen-Wallace Gas Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico, the NE 1/4 of said Section 11 to be dedicated to the well.

CASE 633: Application of Iruco Oil Company for a unit agreement, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-stated case, seeks approval for its Black Warrior Unit area, comprising 1,040 acres, more or less, of Federal and State lands in Townships 23 and 26 South, Range 29 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.

CASE 634: Application of Balco Petroleum Corporation for double commingling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-stated case, seeks approval for the double commingling of Steam and Morrow production in the well known as the Steam and Morrow No. 1 located in Unit 8 of Section 8, Township 22 South, Range 27 East, Carlsbad Field, Eddy County, New Mexico.

CASE 635: Application of Adobe Oil Company for a unit agreement, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-stated case, seeks approval for its East Tule State Unit area, comprising 1,500 acres, more or less, of State lands in Township 12 South, Range 16 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

CASE 636: Application of Petroleum Corporation of Texas for double commingling, San Juan County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-stated case, seeks approval for the double commingling of Fruitland and Fruitland Oil Production in its well known as the Fruitland No. 2, located in Unit 8 of Section 28, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.

CASE 637: Application of Loomis J. Beck for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-stated case, seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Seven River formation underlying each of the following 40-acre tracts in Section 25, Township 25 South, Range 30 East, Lea County, New Mexico: NW 1/4 of Section 25, Township 25 South, Range 30 East, Lea County, New Mexico, to be dedicated to the Seven River No. 1 located in Unit 8.
