STAMETS-DIRECT

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MR. NUTTER: We will call Case No. 5336, which is the southeast nomenclature case calling for the creation and extension of certain pools in Chaves, Eddy and Lea Counties, New Mexico.

Are there appearances in this case?

MR. NUTTER: The record will show Mr. Stamets is still under oath.

R. L. STAMETS

called as a witness, having been previously sworn, was examined and testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. DERRYBERRY:

- Q Would you please state your name and position for the record?
- A R. L. Stamets, Technical Support Chief for the Oil Conservation Commission.
- Q Are you prepared to make recommendations to the Commission concerning the nomenclature in certain pools in Chaves, Eddy and Lea Countles, New Mexico?

A Yes, I am.

STAMETS-DIRECT

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Q Are your recommendations prepared in the form of an exhibit?

A Yes, they are in the form of Exhibit A which is Paragraphs A through Z and AA through CC.

Q Would you please refer to this exhibit and to the docket that has been prepared and distributed at this Hearing and point out any substantial difference between the two?

A Yes. I would like to discuss a couple of these paragraphs in detail, but I think first, just to go through the docket and the overall exhibit.

Everything is identical to the docket except in Paragraph G, we have the addition of Section 31, the southwest quarter in Township 11 South, Range 33 East. In Paragraph K, we have the addition of Section 9, the south half, in Township 21 South, Range 27 East. And in Paragraph S, we have the addition of Section 31. the east half, Section 32, the west half in Township 20 South, Range 30 East. In all other respects, the exhibit is identical to the docket.

Now, I indicated that a couple of these paragraphs needed to be mentioned here. This would be Paragraph B and A relative to the Avalon Pool to be created, and

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Paragraph M. the Catclaw Draw paragraph. The Catclaw Draw Pool was most recently the subject of Case No. 4548, and considered at that time were the proper horizontal limits of the Catclaw Draw Pool. At that time, there was considerable evidence presented relative to structures and pressures existent in the area and in the Avalon area which lies to the east of the Catclaw Pool. The Commission's own staff agreed with the evidence presented at that time and also pressures have been submitted independently to the Commission that tend to verify all of the evidence that was presented at that Hearing, and a result of this is that definite limits for the Catclaw Draw-Morrow Gas Pool have been established at this Hearing for the eastern margin of the pool. There were already existing definite limits on the north end and on the west side due to both the structure and dry holes. The only area that is not completely defined in the Catclaw Draw-Morrow Gas Pool at this time is to the southwest.

The wells which are completed in the Morrow formation east of the Catclaw Pool which might normally be considered as a part of the Catclaw Pool because of their proximity, have been placed in the Avalon-Morrow Gas Pool and are being developed on 320-acre spacing. These

wells, due to pressure and structure information as well as water information, have been classified as a separate Morrow Gas Pool. And, of course, also, there is the Avalon-Strawn. It is not really a problem. It just happens to be in the same area.

Q Do you have anything further to add to your testimony?

A No.

MR. DERRYBERRY: At this time, I would like to ask that the records in Cases 4548 and 5311 be included in the record for purposes of arriving at a decision on the Catclaw-Morrow Pool.

MR. NUTTER: What was the date of those hearings, Mr. Derryberry?

MR. DERRYBERRY: 4548 was on September 4, 1974 as was Case 5311.

MR. NUTTER: The record in Cases 4548 and 5311, both heard September 4th, will be incorporated in the record of this case.

Do you have anything further in this case?

MR. DERRYBERRY: The Commission has received a telegram from the Atlantic Richfield Company which I will read in full:

(Reading) In regard to Case 5336 to be held October 2nd, 1974, concerning nomenclature of certain pools in Eddy County, New Mexico, and in particular, the Avalon-Morrow Gas Pool, Arco requests special consideration be given to those operators, who in good faith filed and completed wells in accordance with Catelaw Braw field rules and dedicated 640 acres to said wells. Arco recommends that those operators be given six months from the effective date of the establishment of new pools in order to comply with the new field regulations. This is requested in order that an operator may not lose any leases as a result of new spacing regulations and that he not be required to immediately drill any wells merely to protect leases from expiration. (End of reading.)

MR. NUTTER: Thank you. Does anyone else have anything further of this witness?

MR. DERRYBERRY: No.

MR. NUTTER: You may be excused.

(Witness dismissed.)

MR. MUTTER: Does anyone have anything they wish to offer in Case No. 5336? We will take the case under advisement.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9:00 a.m. on October 2, 1974, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this 9th day of October, 1974, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new gas pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Morrow formation, said pool to bear the designation of Avalon-Morrow Gas Pool. Said Avalon-Morrow Gas Pool was discovered by the David Fasken El Paso 3 Federal Well No. 1, located in Unit K of Section 3, Township 21 south, Range 26 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Morrow formation on September 11, 1973. The top of the perforations is at 10,708 feet.
- (3) That there is need for the creation of a new gas pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Strawn formation, said pool to bear the designation of Avalon-Strawn Gas Pool. Said Avalon-Strawn Gas Pool was discovered by the David Fasken El Paso 3 Federal Well No. 1, located in Unit K of Section 3, Township 21 South, Range 26 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Strawn formation on November 24, 1973. The top of the perforations is at 9847 feet.
- (4) That there is need for the creation of a new gas pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Mississippian formation, said pool to bear the designation of Denton Camp-Mississippian Gas Pool. Said Denton Camp-

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Mississippian Gas Pool was discovered by The Superior Oil Company Chatten & Muncy Well No. 1, located in Unit O of Section 18, Township 6 South, Range 28 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Mississippian formation on December 13, 1973. The top of the perforations is at 6436 feet.

- (5) That there is need for the creation of a new oil pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Wolfcamp formation, said pool to bear the designation of LaHuerta-Wolfcamp Pool. Said LaHuerta-Wolfcamp Pool was discovered by the Cities Service Oil Company Simpson A Well No. 1, located in Unit H of Section 29, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Molfcamp formation on June 19, 1974. The top of the perforations is at 9007 feet.
- Double L-Queen Associated Pool and the Sams Ranch Grayburg-San Andres Gas Pool, both in Chaves County, New Mexico, the Atoka-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, the Boyd-Morrow Gas Pool, the Burton Flat-Morrow Gas Pool, the Cabin Lake-Morrow Gas Pool, the Catclaw Draw-Morrow Gas Pool, the Cemetary-Morrow Gas Pool, the Eagle Creek-San Andres Pool, the Golden Lane-Morrow Gas Pool, the Golden Lane-Strawn Gas Pool, the Los Medanos-Atoka Gas Pool, the McMillan Seven Rivers-Queen Pool, the Square Lake Grayburg-San Andres Pool, and the Winchester-Morrow Gas Pool, all in Eddy County, New Mexico, the Antelope Ridge-Morrow Gas Pool, the North Bagley-Pennsylvanian Pool, the South Bell Lake-Morrow Gas Pool, the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool, the South Flying "M"-Pennsylvanian Pool, the Monument-Paddock Pool, the South Salt Lake-Morrow Gas Pool, and the Vada-Pennsylvanian Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico.

Pending such compliance, the well shall receive a maximum allowable in the same proportion to a standard allowable for the pool that the acreage dedicated to the well bears to a standard unit for the pool. Failure to file Forms C-102 dedicating a standard unit to the well or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Commission within said 60-day period shall subject the well to cancellation of allowable.
- (2) That the effective date of this order and all creations and extensions included herein shall be November 1, 1974.
