ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a. m. November 20, 1952, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this *7th* day of *December*, 1952, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony adduced and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include:

Township 32 North, Range 10 West, NMPM
All of partial section 7 and all of section 18

Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM
All of Section 2 and 11

- (3) That the boundaries of the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, be, and the same hereby are extended to include:

Township 26 North, Range 10 West, NMPM
All of Section 5 and
S/2 Section 6.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of the Oil Conservation Commission be, and the same hereby is approved, as follows:

- (1) That the boundaries of the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, be, and the same hereby are extended to include:

Township 32 North, Range 10 West, NMPM
All of partial section 7 and all of section 18



(Hearing adjourned.)

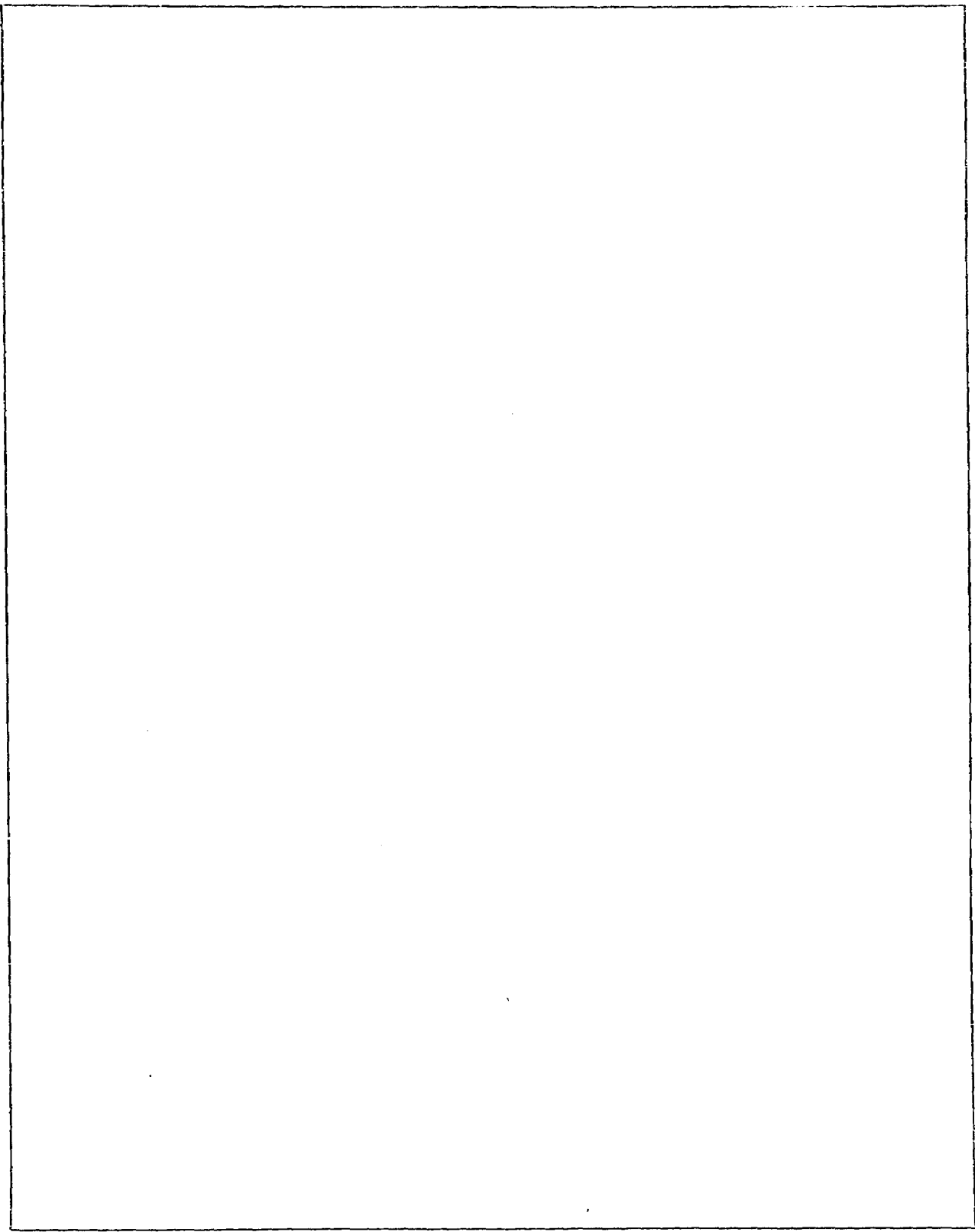
