ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on regularly for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on  
February 17, 1953, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation  
Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 27<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1953, the Commission, a  
quorum being present, having considered the testimony adduced and the  
exhibits presented at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due notice having been given as required by law, the  
Commission has jurisdiction of this cause.
- (2) That by reasons of productive completions in the area, the  
West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool should be extended to include:

Township 26 North, Range 11 West, NMPM  
NW/4 Section 2; NE/4 Section 3.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of the Commission be, and the same hereby  
is approved as follows:

- (a) That the boundaries of the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs  
Pool, as heretofore established, be and the same hereby are extended  
to include:

Township 26 North, Range 11 West, NMPM  
NW/4 Section 2; NE/4 Section 3

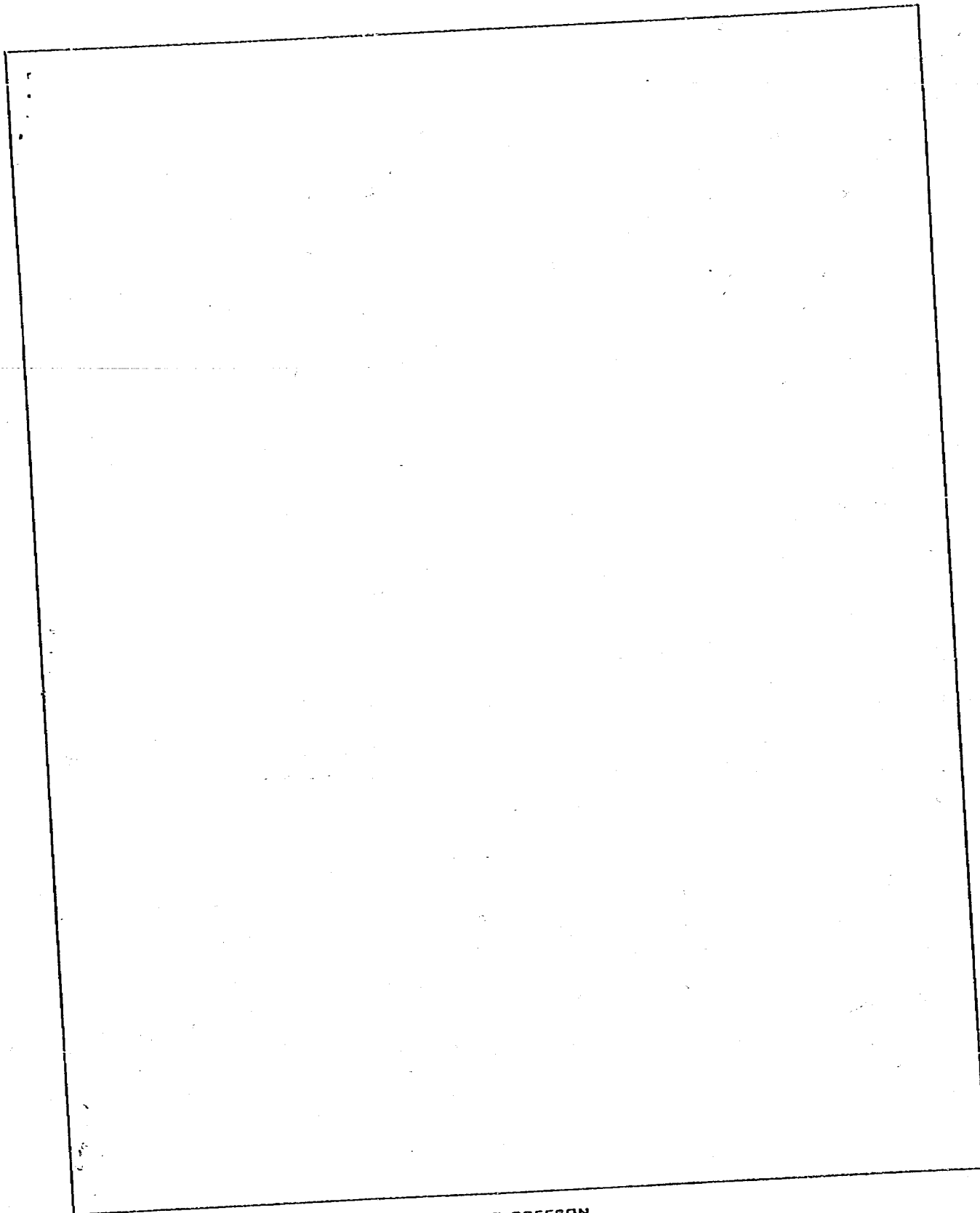
