




Comes now Haynes & V. T. Drilling Company by their Attorneys, Crane & Koogler, and petitions this Honorable Commission for order as an exception to rule 104 (d) concerning drilling units of less than 160 acres in the Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-one (21), Township Twenty-nine (29) North, Range Eleven (11) West, N.M.P.M.

Your petitioner shows:

1. That petitioner is the holder of oil and gas leases on a total of 120 acres within the boundaries of the aforesaid quarter section.
2. That diligent effort has been made to obtain leases on the balance of lands within this quarter section without success.
3. That petitioner is desirous of drilling a well to the Pictured Cliff common source of supply upon the lands held by him and is unable to commit the entire 160 acres of the quarter section as required by commission rule 104 (d).

WHEREFORE, your petitioner prays this commission issue its order granting him an exception to the provisions of rule 104 (d) as to the Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-one (21), Township Twenty-nine (29) North, Range Eleven (11) West, together with suitable provisions for the protection of correlative rights as the commission may determine.
