## ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

# BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on December 17, 1953, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 20 day of January, 1954, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony adduced at the hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

# FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That extensions should be approved for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, Fulcher-Kutz Pictured Cliffs Pool, South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, in accordance with proper advertisement and the testimony presented at the December 17, 1953 hearing.

# IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool boundary as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include:

Twp. 27 North, Rge. 5 West, NYPM
Sections 22, 27, 31, 32, 33 and 34: all

(2) That the Fulcher-Kutz - Pictured Cliffs Pool boundary as here-tofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include:

Twp. 27 North, Rge. 8 West, NAPM Sections 5 and 6, all

(3) That the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool boundary as here-tofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include:

Twp. 26 North, Rge. 7 West, NMFM Sections 1, 11 and 12: all

Twp. 27 North, Rge. 7 West, NNPM Section 36: all

(4) That the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool boundary as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include:

Twp. 30 North, Rge. 11 West, NMFM Section 3: S/2
