

Dear Sir:

I wish to drill a Devonian test on the East 40 acres of the South 63 acres of Section 14, T-13-S, R-38-E, Lea County, New Mexico. There has been on this 63 acre-lease a deep test drilled against the west side, but there is a 40-acre tract left in this 63 acres that has not been drilled on. The deep test was dry.

I wish to make this a 40-acre location unit and I wish to put the well 165 feet from the North line of the 40 and 165 feet from the East line of the 40, or 165 feet from the East line of the section, and 1155 feet from the South line of the Section. It is my understanding that I have to have special permission to do this and after talking to Mr. Pete Porter, of Hobbs, he tells me that I might get a hearing on this matter on November 17th.

My reasons for wanting to drill this unorthodox location is that a fault runs North-South along the west edge of the Bronco Field and to insure the location from getting entangled in this fault zone, I wish to pull it as far East as possible and still have a 40-acre production unit.

I would greatly appreciate hearing from you on this matter. I am sending the filled-out application to Mr. Pete Porter with a copy of this letter to you.
