IN THE MATTER OF THE HEARING CALLED BY THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF NEW MEXICO FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING:

THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVA-TION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER GALLING FOR THE EXTENSION OF EXISTING POOLS IN SAN JUAN AND RIO ARRIBA COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMESSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on December 16, 1954, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Cil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 3 day of January, 1955, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That extension as advertised should be approved for the Bianco-Mesaverde Gas Peol.
- (3) That the proposed extension to the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool is not necessary, inasmuch as Order R-566, signed by the Commission on December 23, 1954, set forth a complete description of the pool and at the same time set up Special Rules and Regulations for the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool; the pool limits as defined therein include the areas proposed for inclusion in Case 803.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico be, and the same hereby is, approved as follows:

(a) That the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

Twp. 26 North, Rge. 4 West, NMPM All of Sections 3 through 10; all of Sections 15, 16, 21, 22, 27, 28, 33 and 34

> Twp. 26 North, Rge. 5 West, NMPM All of Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12

Twp. 22 North, Rge 4 West, NMPM All of Sections 27, 28, 33 and 34

(b) That the proposed extension to the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool be dismissed, action having already been taken to make this provision unnecessary.



called as a witness, having first been duly sworn, upon his oath testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

By: MR. KITTS:

) .

- Q Will you please state your name, your position and place of employment.
- A E. C. Arnold, Geologist for the Oil Conservation Commission, Aztec.
 - Q Are you familiar with Case 803, Mr. Arnold?
 - A Yes. I am.
- Q And in that connection do you have any recommendations to make concerning the extensions of the Blanco-Mesaverde gas field?
- A I recommend that the extension be made as advertised. These recommendations are based upon the completion of the following wells: Southern Union Gas No. 1-F Jicarilla, southwest of Section 27, 26 North, 4 West, completed in the Mesaverde formation with an initial potential of 422 MCF per day.

Southern Union Gas No. 1-G Jicarilla, southwest of Section 1-26 North, 5 west, initial potential of 1,227 MCF per day.

Ralph A. Johnston No. 23 Rincon Unit in the southwest of Section 35, 27 North, 7 West, with an initial potential of 236 MCF per day.

And the J. Glen Turner No. 6, State, in the southwest of Section 16, 32 North, 6 West, initial potential of 1175 MCF per day.

Q Do you also have recommendations to make concerning extensions of the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

- A Yes.
- Q And if so, will you state what they are and the basis for them.

A Yes. I recommend that the extension be made as advertised. These extensions are based upon the completion of the following three wells: Western Natural Gas Krause No. 1, southwest of Section 29, 28 north, 11 west, initial potential of 145 MCF per day.

Benton Montin Gallegos Canyon Unit No. 68 in the northeast of Section 14, 28 north, 12 west, with an initial potential of 113 MCF per day.

Southern Union Gas Robinson No. 1 in the northwest of Section 22, 29 north, 13 west, with an initial potential of 108 MCF per day.

- Q Do you have anything further, Mr. Arnold?
- A No, sir, I believe that covers it. I would like to offer this description.

MR. KITTS: Will you mark that Exhibit 1.
(Document marked by witness as Exhibit 1.)

- Q This was prepared by you, Mr. Arnold?
- A Yes, sir.
- Q We offer Commission's Exhibit No. 1 in evidence.
