# ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

# BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m., on January 13, 1955, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this day of February, 1955, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the records and testimony adduced, and being fully advised in the promises,

#### FINDS:

- 1. That due notice of the time and place of hearing and the purpose thereof having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this case and the subject matter thereof.
- 2. That pursuant to provisions of Rule 7 (a) of Order No. R-372-A, the Commission has power and authority to permit the formation of a gas proration unit consisting of other than a legal quarter section after notice and hearing by the Commission.
- 3. That applicant, Famariss Petroleum Corporation, is the owner of an oil and gas lease in Lea County, New Mexico, the land consisting of other than a legal quarter section, and described as follows, to-wit:

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM Lots 2, 7, and 10 of Section 4

containing 120 acres, more or less.

- 4. That applicant, Famaries Petroleum Corporation, has a preducing well on the aforesaid lease known as the E. C. Hill No. 1, located in Lot No. 10, 3300' from the north line and 1730' from the east line of Section 4, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County,
- 5. That the aferesaid well is located within the herizontal and New Mexico. vertical limits of the poel heretofore delineated and designated as the Blinebry Gas Poel.
- 6. That it is impractical to posl applicant's said lease with adjoining acreage, and that the owners of adjoining acreage in said section have not objected to the formation of the proposed proration unit of 129 acres.
- 7. That unless a proration unit consisting of applicant's aforesaid acreage is permitted, applicant will be deprived of the opportunity to recover its just and equitable share of the natural gas from the Blinebry
- 8. That creation of a proration unit consisting of the aforesaid Gas Poel. acreage will not cause but will prevent waste and will protect correlative
- 9. That all the acreage in the proposed unit is reasonably rights. presumed to be productive of gas at the present time from the Blinebry Gas Pool.

# IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the application of Famaries Petroleum Corporation for approval of a non-standard proration unit consisting of the following described acreage:

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM Lots 2, 7, and 10 of Section 4

be and the same is hereby approved, and a proration unit consisting of the aforesaid acreage is hereby created.

2. That, for the purposes of gas proration in the Blinebry Gas Pool, the acreage included in said unit is hereby assigned to the Famariss Petroleum Corporation's E. C. Hill No. 1, located in Lot 10 of Section 4, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, and that said well shall be granted an allowable from the 1st day of March, 1955, in the proportion that 120 acres bears to the standard or orthodox proration unit for the Blinebry Gas Pool, all until further order of the Commission

By this letter of application, the Famariss Petroleum Corporation wishes to state the following:

- 1. Reference is made to our application for nonstandard unit, dated October 13, 1954, which is on file with the Commission. The above application should be made a part hereto and a copy of such is attached.
- 2. Famariss Petroleum Corporation, et al, is the holder of the oil and gas lease covering Lot #10 on which lot the said Hill #1 well is located.
- 3. Effective December 13, 1954, the Monterey Oil Company assigned their 7/3 lease covering Lots 2, 7, to Famariss Petroleum Corporation, et al. A copy of this assignment is attached.

- 4. Prior to December 1, 1954, Lots 2 and 7 were held under lease by the Fullerton Oil Company of Pasadena, California. Effective December 1, 1954, Monterey Oil Company of Los Angeles, California purchased the lease covering Lots 2 and 7.
- 5. Since the time of the application; No. 1 above, it has come to our attention that the lease held by the Fullerton Oil Company (now Monterey Oil Company) did not have a "peeling clause" as to gas production and the production of fluid incidental to the production of gas.

As operator of this proposed gas unit, we have assumed the responsibility of obtaining approval from the various lease-held interests to pool all of the acreage in the proposed gas unit for the purpose of producing gas and incidental fluids from the well lecated in Lot #10 of the application.

We have been successful in obtaining this agreement from the various interests with the following exceptions:

#### RE-DIRECT EXAMINATION

# By MR. GIRAND:

Q In regard to the location of the well bore, will you just briefly state for the record, the topographical location that was found there?

A Yes, sir. This well is located in what was called the Monument-Draw. The actual 660 measurement came out on top of a knoll, a small rise in the ground, that was covered by a hard limestone cap there, and in order to put the well on that particular spot, we would had to have done a considerable amount of dirt work and blasting, and so on, in order to put the rig up and have room for our pipe racks, our pits and things like that. A conservative estimate on dirt work and blasting work to clear the location would be in excess of, oh, \$8,000.00.

Q The entire matter was submitted to the Commission before the commencement of drilling?

A Yes, it was.

MR. GIRAND: Thank you. That is all.

MR. MACEY: Any other questions of the witness? If not the witness may be excused. We will take Case 817 under advisement and proceed to Case 818.
