

Humble Oil & Refining Company respectively requests an examiner hearing at Hobbs, New Mexico, to consider productive tests to be taken on Humble's New Mexico State "G" Well No. 5, and the granting of a permit to dual complete and form 320 acre non-standard gas unit. In support of our request for a hearing, we submit the following 6/4/4

1. New Mexico State "G" Well No. 5 is located 1980 feet from North line, 660 feet from West line of Section 23, T-21-S, R-36-E, Eumont Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Re:

- 2. Well was drilled to a total depth of 3830 feet in 1952 and abandoned as a dry hole.
- 3. We have re-entered abandoned hole and are now testing the lower Queen through perforated section 3738 3783 feet. We expect to complete this section as an oil well and produce it through the tubing.
- 4. We propose to perforate the upper Queen at approximate intervals 3655 3700 feet and produce it as a gas well through the casing.
- 5. A packer will be set so as to segregate the producing intervals.
- 6. The dual completion of this well will be in the interest of conservation and the mechanics of the dual completion are feasible and practical.
- 7. The proposed non-standard gas unit is the 320 acres described as the west half of Section 23, T-21-S, R-36-E.
- 8. The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section and consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections which may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.

- 9. Copies of this application have been furnished to all offset operators by certified mail.
- 10. Attached is a diagrammatic sketch of proposed completion and a location plat.


