

### TO THE NEW MEXICO OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION:

Now comes El Paso Natural Gas Company and requests the Commission to set a hearing before an Examiner at the Hobbs, New Mexico Office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission and grant an exception to Rule 5(a) of that part of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order Number R-520 pertaining to the Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, for its Harrison Federal #1 Well, and for its grounds therefor states:

- 1. That R. Olsen completed the R. Olsen Harrison Federal #1 Well on December 13, 1955. That said well is located 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 27, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M. This well was drilled to a total of 3370 feet and was plugged back to 3110 feet and is now a gas well producing from the Jalmat Gas Pool. On December 12, 1955, this well tested 9,700 MCF per day absolute open flow.
- 2. That by Bill of Sale dated May 25, 1956, R. Olsen sold this well to El Paso Natural Gas Company.
- 3. That El Paso Natural Gas Company and Westates Petroleum Company hold the gas operating rights under the S/2 of Section 27, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., and that they have agreed to communitize their interests insofar as they cover the Yates, Seven River and/or Queen Formations in order to form a 320 acre unit consisting of said S/2 of Section 27, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., subject to the approval of this Application. El Paso Natural Gas Company will be the Unit Operator.
- 4. That the proposed Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
- 5. That the entire proposed Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.

- 6. That the length and width of the proposed Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit does not exceed 5280 feet.
- 7. That there is attached hereto a plat showing the acreage to be dedicated to the proposed Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit, the location of the well, and the offset ownership.
- 8. That the granting of the exception requested herein will not adversely affect the correlative rights of any offset owner and will protect the correlative rights of Applicant, will prevent waste, will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, and is in the interest of conservation.


