FINDS:

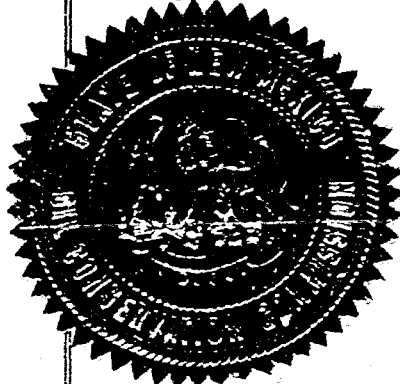

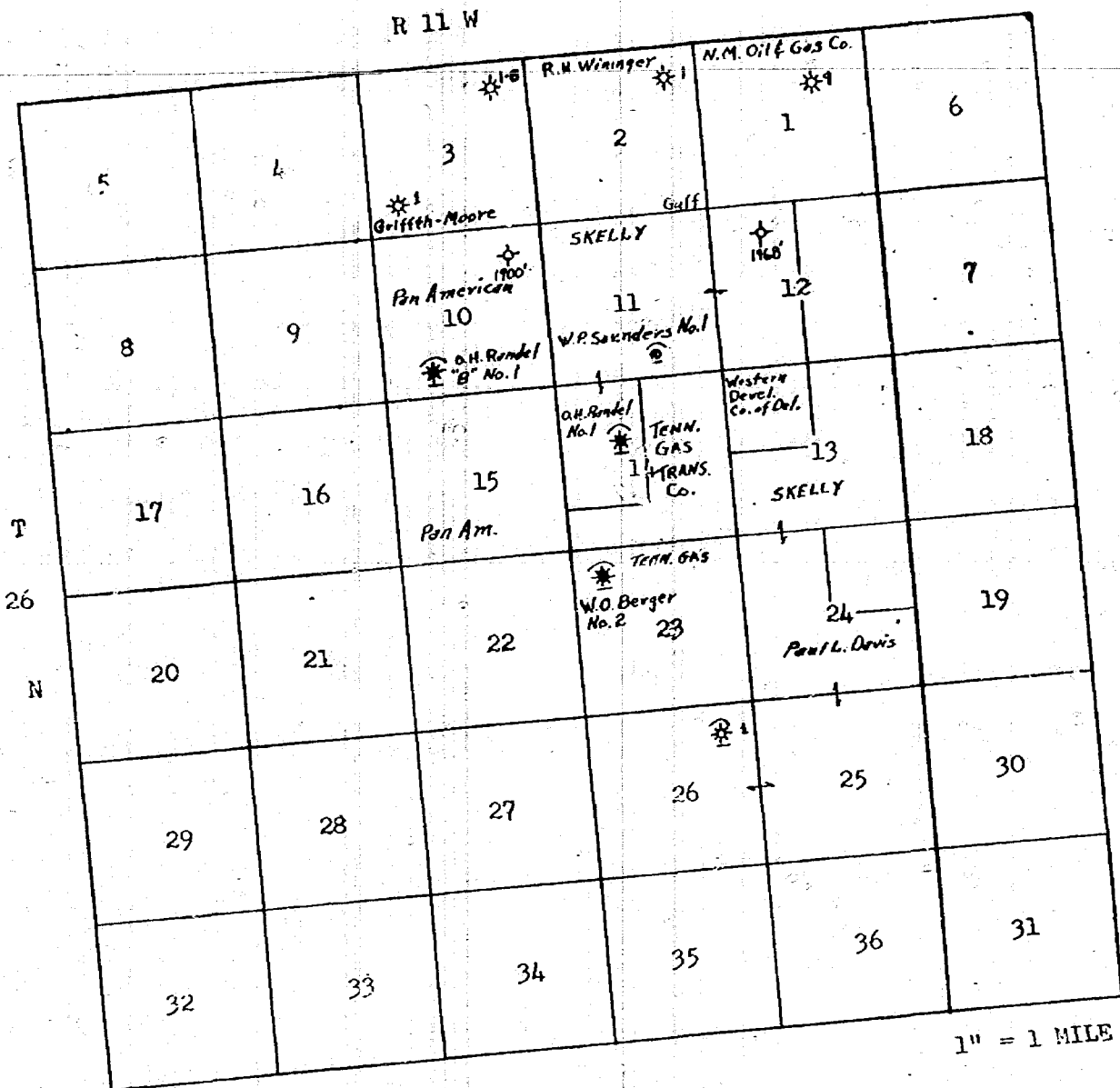

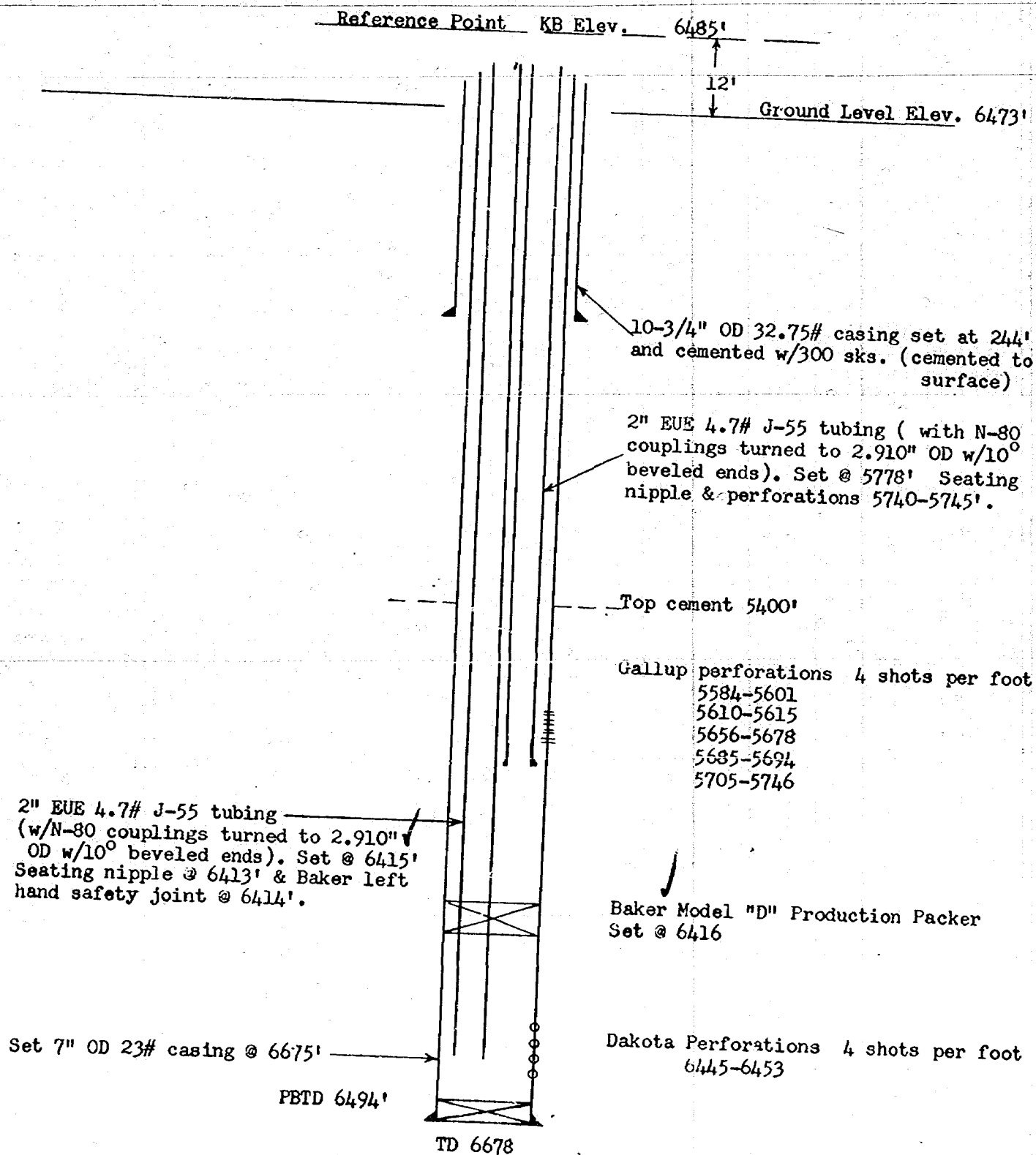
