Dear Mr. Porter:

Application is hereby made for exception to Rule-1417 and Rule-107-E to apply to the E. P. Campbell No. 1 Kleeman located 660 feet from the south line and 330 feet from the east line of Section 27, Town-ship 18 South, Range 26 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The applicant proposes to drill the subject well from the present total depth of 6425 feet with 4-3/4 inch hole size to an approximate total depth of 9400 feet to test and attempt completion by "slim-noie" method in the Atoka Pennsylvanian Gas Pool. Inasmuch as this well is located within one mile of the boundary of the Atoka Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, exception is requested to the normal spacing pattern now established. Because the 4-3/4 inch hole to be drilled would not provide adequate clearance for a proper cement shut-off between zones below the present total depth, it is proposed that 2-7/8 inch tubing be set and cemented through the Pennsylvanian gas pay. This well is now producing approximately one-half barrel oil per day from the Dayton-Abo pay zone.

It is requested that these proposals be given consideration administratively or by hearing at your earliest convenience.


