### ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

### BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on December 13, 1961, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 18th day of December, 1961, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

#### FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this colse and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Delaward formation, said pool to bear the designation Cruz-Delaware Pool. Said Cruz-Delaware Pool was discovered by Continental Oil Company, Marshal 19 No. 1, located in the SW/4, Unit M, of Section 19, Township 23 South, Range 33 East, NMPM. It was completed September 20, 1961. The top of perforations is 5095 feet.
