

The following information is furnished in response to your February 21, 1962 telephonic request confirmed by a letter dated February 21, 1962.

A Casinghead Gas Contract dated July 17, 1961 between El Paso Natural Gas Company, Buyer, and Jalou Gas Company (formerly Knight Manufacturing and Supply Company), Seller, covers gas produced from the above mentioned area and provides that Buyer agrees to purchase a daily quantity of twenty (20) million cubic feet of gas at 15.025 pounds pressure base.

Attached is a schedule showing the total of the daily volumes received from the various points at which Seller delivers gas to Bayer for the most recent 30 days that information is available.

The 6 x 5 compressor on the subject order, was ordered by your Company on October 31, 1961. Since this was not a stock size carried in our Tulsa Warehouse, we had to order the unit for shipment from our Buffalo, N. Y. Plant.

Shipment was originally promised for January 12, 1962, then later rescheduled to January 26, 1962. We actually received the machine in Tulsa on February 19, 1962.

At the moment, we are not in position to explain the delay in shipment except to state that this particular size is not a popular size for gas service and evidently even the castings had to be made especially for this order rather than employing stock cylinder castings.



Dear Mr. Porter:

Application is hereby made by Elliott, Inc. for a thirty day exception to Order No. R-2103 for our Totah No. 1-A, located in the NE NE Sec. 30, Twp. 29N., Rge. 13W., San Juan County, New Mexico.

A field inspection shows the off-set wells to our lease to be producing, which is subjecting our property to drainage.

Our tank battery is relatively isolated from the rest of the field and being a one well battery, whereas the majority of the field is being produced into central tank batteries involving numerous wells into each battery, it is only logical that the gas gathering system should be completed to the larger batteries first.

We are advised by Knight Manufacturing and Supply Company that we cannot expect to be connected to their system before February 15 and in view of previous delays we feel it will probably be at least thirty days before they will be able to make their installation as it is going to require a separate compressor for this one well tank battery.

In view of the drainage being effected on our lease and the fact that we are making every effort to expedite the gathering of this gas, we feel that this can be classified as "undue hardship" and respectfully request that the Commission grant us a thirty day exception to the above referenced Commission Order.

The only off-set owner is Aztec Oil & Gas Company and they are being notified by a copy hereof.
