THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CREATING, ABOLISHING AND EXTENDING CERTAIN POOLS IN EDDY, CHAVES, ROOSEVELT AND LEA COUNTIES. NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on Merch 14, 1962, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereisafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 19th day of March, 1962, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

PINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is used for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico for the production of oil from the Cisco formation, said pool to bear the designation Baish-Cisco Peol. Said Baich-Cisco Pool was discovered by Continental Oil Company, M. E. Baish "A" No. 27, located in the SE/4, Unit I, of Section 21, Township 17 South, Range 32 East NMPM. It was completed June 15, 1959. Top of perforations is 10,726 feet.

- (3) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the San Andres formation, said pool to bear the designation Pecos-San Andres Pool. Said Pecos-San Andres Pool was discovered by Peters Drilling Company, Dale Federal No. 1, located in the NW/4, Unit E, of Section 38, Tewnship 7 South, Range 26 East, NMPM. It was completed October 29, 1961. The top of perforations is 1128 feet.
- (4) That there is need for the creation of a new poel in Roosevelt County, New Mexico for the production of oil from the (Pennsylvanian) Bough C formation, said pool to bear the designation East Prairie-Pennsylvanian Poel. Said East Prairie-Pennsylvanian Poel was discovered by Cosden Petroleum Corporation, Pederal J No. 1, located in the SW/4, Unit K, of Section 23, Township 6 South, Range 36 East, NMPM. It was completed August 14, 1961. The top of perforations is 9698 feet.
- (5) That the proposed creation of a new pool in Section 27, Township 21 South, Range 29 Sast, Eddy County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Brushy Canyon formation should be dismissed pending further study.
- (6) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Los County, New Mexico for the production of oil from the Bone Springs formation, said pool to bear the designation Scharb-Bone Crained Pool. Said Scharb Bone Springs Pool was discovered by The Ohio Oil Company, State NPA No. 1, located in the SW/4, Unit L, of Section 6, Tewnship 19 South, Range 35 East, NMPM. It was completed January 18, 1962. The top of perforations is 10,152 feet.
- (7) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Wolfcamp formation, said pool to bear the designation South Tulk-Wolfcamp Pool. Said South Tulk-Wolfcamp Pool was discovered by Great Western Drilling Company, Town No. 1, located in the NW/4, Unit C, of Section 18, Township 15 South, Range 35 East, NMPM. It was completed January 20, 1962. The top of perforations is 9652 feet.
- (8) That there is need for the abolishment of the Baish-Pennsylvanian Pool to prevent overlap with the Maljamar-Strawn Peel. This pool shall be recreated as the Baish-Cisco Peel.
- (9) That there is need for the abolishment of the East Vacuum-Abo Pool inasmuch as it is contiguous with and has the same reservois as the Vacuum-Abo Pool, and shall become a part of the Vacuum-Abo Pool

(10) That there is need for certain extensions to the Allison-Pennsylvanian Pool in Roosevelt County, and the Atoka-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, the North Hackberry-Yates Pool, the West Heashaw-Grayburg Pool, the Shugart (Yates-Seven Rivers-Queen-Grayburg) Pool, and the North Square Lake Grayburg-San Andres Pool all in Eddy County, New Mexico, the Blinetry Pool, the Crosby-Devonian Gas Pool, the Justis Tubb-Drinkard Pool, the North Justis-Ellenburger Pool, the North Justis Tubb-Drinkard Pool, the Naljamar Strawn Pool, the Paddock Pool, the Poarl-Queen Pool, the Sand Springs-Devonian Pool, and the Vacuum-Abo Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico.

Q Mr. Ramey, have you determined that the Commission should create new pools, extend and abolish certain existing pools in Eddy, Lea, Roosevelt and Chaves Counties, New Mexico?

- Yes, I have.
- And have you prepared an exhibit reflecting those recommendations?
 - Α Yes, I have.
- Referring to that exhibit, Mr. Ramey, Paragraph (a), what is your recommendation concerning the creation of a new oil pool for Cisco production?

It is recommended that a new oil pool be created and designated as the Baish-Cisco Pool, vertical limits to be the Cisco member of the Pennsylvanian formation, and horizontal limits should be as shown in Paragraph (a) of Exhibit 1. The discovery well was Continental Cil Company M.E. Baish "A" Number 27 located in Unit I, Section 21, Township 17 South, Ranch 32 East and was completed on June 15, 1959; top of perforations is at 10,726 feet.

mr. Ramey, referring to Paragraph (b) of your exhibit, do you have a recommendation concerning the creation of a new oil pool for San Andres production?

It is recommended that a new oil pool be created and designated as the Scharb-Bone Springs Pool, vertical limits to be the Bone Springs and horizontal limits as shown in Exhibit 1; discovery well was the Ohio Oil Company - State NPA Number 1 located in Unit L, Section 6, Township 19 South, Range 35 East and was completed on January 18, 1962; top of perforations is at 10,152 feet.

What is your recommendation concerning the creation of Q a new oil pool for Wolfcamp production?

That a new pool be created and designated as South Tulk-Wolfcamp Pool, vertical limits to be the Wolfcamp formation, and horizontal limits as show in Paragraph (f); discovery well was Great Western Dril Company - Town No. 1, located in Section 18, Township 16 South, Range 35 East, and was completed on January 20, 1962; top of perforations is at 9,652 feet.

Referring to Paragraph (g) of the exhibit, what are your recommendations concerning the Blish-Pennsylvanian Pool?

It is recommended that the Baish-Pennsylvanian Pool be abolished to prevent overlap with the Maljamar-Strawn Pool.

Referring to Paragraph (h) of the exhibit, what is your recommendation concerning the East Vacuum-Abo Pool?

Recommended that the pool be abolished because it is now contiguous and has the same reservoir as the Vacuum-Abo Pool.



This will become a part of the Vacuum-Abo Pool.

- Mr. Ramey, do Paragraphs (i) through (x) of Exhibit Number 1 accurately reflect your recommendation concerning the extension of certain existing pools?
 - Yes, they do.
- Does your recommendation in any way, as shown upon your Exhibit Number 1, deviate from the information shown on the Docket?
 - No, I don't think so.
 - No paragraphs to be dismissed?
 - No, no further dismissals.

MR. MORRIS: If the Commission please, I move the introduction of Exhibit Number 1 in Case 2505 with the exception of the Paragraph (d) which should be dismissed, and move the Commission to take the action recommended by Mr. Ramey concerning this exhibit.

MR. PORTER: There is one question I had. There was a reference to a Bough C formation of the Pennsylvanian that I didn't--

MR. MORRIS: Mr. Ramey corrected his testimony with respect to Paragraph (c) that the vertical limits should be the Pennsylvanian formation rather than the Bough C.

I agree with you.

MR. PORTER: That was the point I wanted to clear up.

MR. MORRIS: That concludes the examination of the wit-



MR. PORTER: Do you offer your exhibit, Mr. Morris?

MR. MORRIS: I offer Exhibit Number 1, yes, sir.

MR. PORTER: Exhibit Number 1 will be admitted to the

record. Any question of Mr. Ramey? You may be excused.

MR. PORTER: Anything further to be offered in the case? The Commission will take the case under advisement. The hearing is adjourned.
