FINDS:

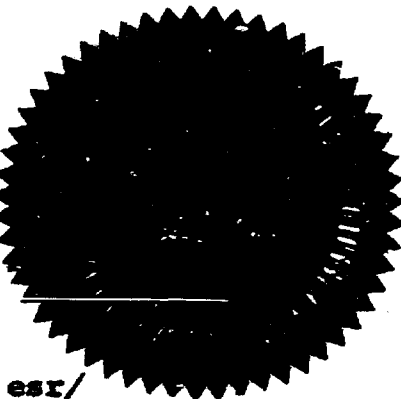
(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

YOUR LETTER OF FEBRUARY 19, 1962 REQUESTED OUR APPROVAL AS A WORKING INTEREST OWNER IN THE GALLEGOS CANYON UNIT TO A NON-STANDARD DAKOTA GAS UNIT COVERING THE NW/4 SECTION 23, T=29-N, R=13-W. YOUR SUBSEQUENT LETTER OF APRIL 2, 1962 NOW PROPOSES THE VOLUNTARY COMMUNITIZATION OF THE N/2 OF SECTION 23 IN THE BASIN DAKOTA ZONE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE OIL AND GAS LEASES COVERING THIS 320 ACRES THIS WILL ADVISE THAT TEXACO INC IS AWARE OF NO LEGAL BASIS UPON WHICH THIS VOLUNTARY COMMUNITIZATION OF THE N/2 OF SECTION 23 CAN BE ACCOMPLISHED. AS STATED IN YOUR PROPOSED COMMUNITIZATION AGREEMENT, 146.80 ACRES WITHIN THE NE/4 OF SECTION 23 IS COMMITTED TO THE GALLEGOS CANYON UNIT AGREEMENT AND UNIT OPERATING AGREEMENT AS TO THE WORKING INTEREST AND A PORTION THEREOF IS ALSO COMMITTED AS TO ITS ROYALTY INTEREST. IT IS OUR BELIEF THAT A COMMUNITIZATION OF THE COMMITTED UNIT ACREAGE IN THE NE/4 OF SECTION 23 WITH UNCOMMITTED ACREAGE IN THE NW/4 OF SECTION 23 WILL REQUIRE THE UNANIMOUS APPROVAL OF ALL PARTIES TO BOTH OF THE UNIT AGREEMENTS. WE CONTINUE AT THIS TIME IN OUR DESIRE TO SEE ALL OF THE ACREAGE IN THE N/2 OF SECTION 23 COMMITTED TO THE GALLEGOS CANYON UNIT AGREEMENTS. HOWEVER, WE WILL NOT OPPOSE YOUR HEARING BEFORE THE OIL CONSERVATION

- CASE 2521: Application of Pan American Petroleum Corporation for a non-standard gas proration unit, San Juan County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks the establishment of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool, comprising the NW/4 of Section 23, Township 29 North, Range 13 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, said unit to be dedicated to the Gallegos Canyon Unit Well No. 94 located 1850 feet from the North and West lines of said Section 23.
- CASE 2522: Application of Shell Oil Company for a dual completion, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks permission to complete its State GA Well No. 2, located in Unit N of Section 16, Township 15 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico, as a dual completion (conventional) in the Caudill Permo-Pennsylvanian and Caudill-Devonian Pools with the production of oil from the Permo-Pennsylvanian zone to be through a string of 1-inch tubing and the production of oil from the Devonian zone to be through a parallel string of 2 1/16-inch tubing, a hydraulic casing pump and the casing-tubing annulus.
- CASE 2523: Application of Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., for an unorthodox gas well location, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Gentlemen:

Reference is made to our telegram of March 12, 1962, concerning the application of Pan American Petroleum Corporation for administrative approval of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Basin Dakota Pool consisting of the NW/4 of Section 23, T-29-N, R-13-W, San Juan County, New Mexico. In Pan American's application letter of February 19, 1962, they state that the non-standard unit will be dedicated to the Gallegos Canyon Unit Well No. 94, which is located 1850' from the north line and 1850' from the west line of said Section 23.

Pan American has stated that the non-standard unit is within the unit boundary of the Gallegos Canyon Unit, but the royalty interests of this acreage are not committed to the Gallegos Canyon Unit. We believe that this infers that the working interest for this acreage has been dedicated to the Gallegos Canyon Unit; however, we were advised by a telegram from Pan American dated March 9, 1962, that neither the working interest nor royalty interest in the NW/4 of said Section 23 was committed to the Unit.

Texaco Inc. as a working interest owner in the Gallegos Canyon Unit objects to the formation of a permanent non-standard gas proration unit. Texaco, however, has no objection to an administrative order approving a six month temporary non-standard gas unit on the condition that Pan American will commit this acreage to the Gallegos Canyon Unit and form a standard 320 acre unit.



Texaco believes that if this non-standard unit was approved on a permanent basis and Pan American did not commit the acreage to the Gallegos Canyon Unit it would be necessary for the Unit to drill an unnecessary well in the NE/4 of said Section 23 and ask that a 160-acre non-standard gas unit be dedicated to such a well. Texaco believes that in order to insure the protection of the correlative rights of all parties concerned, a standard 320-acre unit consisting of the N/2 of said Section 23 should be formed.

Pursuant to the provisions of Rule 5-B of Order R-1670-C, Pan American Petroleum Corporation hereby makes Administrative Application for the approval of a Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit in the Basin Dakota Pool consisting of the NW/4 of Section 23, T-29-N, R-13-W, San Juan County, New Mexico. The proposed 160-acre Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit, consisting of the NW/4 of Section 23, will be dedicated to Gallegos Canyon Unit Well No. 94, which has been staked at a location 1850' from the north line and 1850' from the west line of Section 23.

This request for the establishment of a Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit for the Basin Dakota Pool is occasioned by the fact that the NW/4 of Section 23 is within the boundary of the Gallegos Canyon Unit, but the royalty interests of this acreage are not committed to the Gallegos Canyon Unit Agreement. It is Pan American's intention to eventually form a Standard Gas Proration Unit for the Basin Dakota Pool consisting of the N/2 of Section 23 but unless we are successful in obtaining royalty interest commitment of this acreage, a Communitization Agreement between this acreage and the Gallegos Canyon Unit Dakota Participating Area will be necessary. Negotiations among so many owners on the terms of a Communitization Agreement may require a considerable amount of time, and we desire to drill the well immediately and be able to obtain an allowable for it.

The attached map shows the non-standard unit and the ownership of acreage in its vicinity.

In making this application for Administrative approval of a Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit, Pan American states the following:

1. The proposed non-standard unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections or lots.


