

Gentlemen:

Phillips Petroleum Company respectfully requests administrative approval for exception to the well location requirements in Statewide Rule 104, Paragraph 2 (c) for the subject well. It is our intention to drill Santa Fe Well No. 68 to be located 1650 feet from North and 1090 feet from East lines of Sec. 34. T17S. R35E. Lea County. The attached plat shows this proposed location and offset properties.

There is presently in Unit H Phillips' Santa Fe Well No. 44, Vacuum Pool, located 1650 feet from North and 990 feet from East lines of Section 34. The proposed drillsite for Well No. 68 would be 100 feet West from Well No. 44. It is our opinion that to drill Well No. 68 to the east or south would structurally be a poor risk for successful completion in the Abo formation.

Ownership of all oil and gas leases within a radius of 660 feet of the proposed location is common with the ownership of the oil and gas leases under the proposed location.


