THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION CONDISSION UPON ITS OWN MCTION FOR AN ORDER EXTENDING CERTAIN POOLS IN RIO ARRINA AND SAN JUAN COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSIOM:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on June 14, 1962, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

MOW, on this 15th day of June, 1962, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises.

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for certain extensions to the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool and to the Flora Vista-Mesaverde Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, to the South Blanco-Tocito Dil Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, and to the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool in Rio Arriba and San Juan Counties, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:
