Humble Oil and Refining Company's request for Administrative Approval to complete its F. F. Hardison "B" 2 well, located in Unit A, Section 34, T-21-S, R-37-N, Lea County, New Mexico, as a dual Hlinebry Oil-Tubb Gas producer, was denied due to the proposed dual strings of 1-1/2-inch tubing being below the minimum of 1.67 inches inside diameter.

As a result of the telephone conversation between our Mr. B. K. Beville and Mr. Dan Nutter, Humble will run two strings of 2-1/16-inch tubing in this well, having an inside diameter of 1.75 inches, which will meet requirements for Administrative Approval.
