ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on July 18, 1962, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 20th day of July, 1962, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico for the production of oil from the Wolfcamp formation, said pool to bear the designation Baish-Wolfcamp Pool. Said Baish-Wolfcamp Pool was discovered by Continental Oil Company, Baish B No. 14, located in the NW/4, Unit C, of Section 22, Township 17 South, Range 32 East, NMPM. It was completed May 11, 1962. The top of perforations is 9808 feet.

(3) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico for the production of oil from the San Andres formation, said pool to bear the designation Mescalero-San Andres Pool. Said Mescalero-San Andres Pool was discovered by Cities Service Production Company, State AD No. 2, located in the SE/4, Unit I, of Section 22, Township 10 South, Range 32 East, NMPM. It was completed May 11, 1962. The top of perforations is 4200 feet.

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(4) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico for the production of oil from the Wolfcamp formation, said pool to bear the designation Tonto-Wolfcamp Pool. Said Tonto-Wolfcamp Pool was discovered by Pan American Petroleum Corporation, Laguna Plata Federal Unit No. 1, located in the SE/4, Unit I, of Section 22, Township 19 South, Range 33 East, NWM. It was completed April 28, 1962. The top of perforations is 11,100 feet.

(5) That there is need for the deletion of certain acreage from the Summit Gas Pool in order to clarify nomenclature. Deleted area to be extended to South Eunice Pool and Jalmat Gas Pool.

(6) That there is need for certain extensions to the Cedar Lake-Abo Pool, North Hackberry-Tates Pool, Jackson-Abo Pool, Love Hills Pool, East Millman Queen-Grayburg Pool, Shagart Pool, and the North Square Lake Grayburg-San Andres Pool, all in Sibley County, New Mexico, the Milnesand-San Andres Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, the Arkansas Junction-Queen Gas Pool, Blinabry Oil Pool, Bronco-Wolfcamp Pool, Corbin-Abo Pool, South Eunice Pool, Jalmat Gas Pool, Justin-Blinabry Pool, Oil Center-Blinabry Pool, Quail Ridge-Bone Springs Pool, Reeves-Devonian Pool, Salado Draw-Bellevue Pool and the Vacuum-Abo Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico.

Q Please state your name and position?

A Joe D. Ramy, District Supervisor for the New Mexico Oil
Conservation Commission.

Q Mr. Ramy, are you prepared to recommend to the Commission
an order creating new pools and extending and abolishing the old

pools in Eddy, Lea and Roosevelt Counties, New Mexico?

A Yes, sir. I am.

Q And in that regard, have you prepared an Exhibit in this Case?

A Yes, sir. I have.

Q Referring to this Exhibit, what is your recommendation as to the Baish-Wolfcamp project?

A It is recommended that the new oil pool of the Baish-Wolfcamp Pool have certain vertical limits capable of producing. The Wolfcamp, Paragraph A, Exhibit 1 lists Discovery Well as Continental Oil Company-Baish 1-B No. 14 located in Unit C of Section 22, Township 17 South, Range 32 East and completed on May 11, 1962. Top of perforations 9,808 feet.

Q And what is your recommendation referring to paragraph B concerning the creation of a new oil pool for San Andres production?

A It is recommended that the new oil pool known as the Mescalero-San Andres have certain vertical limits, San Andres form and important limits and as shows in the Paragraph B, Exhibit 1, Discovery Well is Cities Service Production Company, -State AD No. 2 in Unit I of Section 22, Township 10 South, Range 32 East, completed May 11, 1962. Top of perforations 4200 feet.

Q Referring to paragraph C, the creation of a new oil pool for Tonto-Wolfcamp production?

A It is recommended the Tonto-Wolfcamp pool have certain



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vertical limits to be as shown in Paragraph C, Exhibit 1. The Discovery Well is Pan American Petroleum Corporation, -Laguna Plata Federal Unit No. 1 in Unit I of Section 22, Township 19 South, Range 33 East and completed April 28, 1962. Top of perforations is at 11,180 feet.

Q Referring to Paragraph D, what is your recommendation concerning deletion in the Eumont Gas Pool?

A It is recommended that the Eumont Gas Pool be deleted. That a portion be deleted as shown in Paragraph D, Exhibit 1. This deleted area will be extended to the South Eunice Pool and Jalmat Gas Pool.

Q Mr. Ramy, with respect to Paragraphs E through X of this Exhibit, do these paragraphs accurately reflect the proposed extensions of the various pools in Eddy, Lee and Roosevelt Counties, New Mexico?

A Yes, sir. Paragraphs F through X accurately reflect the extensions for which extended additions have been made.

Q Would you explain those, please?

A Those are shown on the Exhibit, that is with additions that were made after the advertisement, which is a common change advertisement.

Q Mr. Ramy, do you have anything further you would like to add at this time?

A No. That is all I have.
