This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on Movember 8, 1962, at Santa Fo, New Mexico, before Daniel S. Mutter, Enuminer duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 21st day of Movember, 1962, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Daniel S. Nutter, and being fully advised in the premises,

FIEDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Gulf Oil Corporation, seeks authority to complete its Graham State (MCT-I) Well Mo. 2, located in Unit L of Section 19, Township 21 South, Range 37 Hast, HMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, as a triple completion (conventional) to produce oil from the Fuddock, Blinebry, and Drinkard Oil Pools through parallel strings of 2 3/8-inch tubing, separation of the zones to be achieved by means of packers set at approximately 5800 feet and 6600 feet.
- (3) That the mechanics of the proposed triple completion are feasible and in accord with good conservation practices.
- (4) That approval of the subject application will neither cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the applicant, Gulf Oil Corporation, is hereby authorized to complete its Graham State (MCT-I) Well No. 2, located in Unit L of Section 19, Township 21 South, Range 37 Bast,

EMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, as a triple completion (conventional) to produce oil from the Paddock, Blinebry, and Drinkard Oil Pools through parallel strings of 2 3/8-inch tubing, separation of the zones to be achieved by means of packers set at approximately 5800 feet and 6600 feet.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall complete, operate and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations insofar as said rule is not inconsistent with this order.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That the applicant shall take packerleakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Gas-Oil Ratio Test Period for the Brinkard Oil Pool.

(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.



MR. DURETTE: Case 2685. Application of Gulf Oil Corporation for a triple completion, Lea County, New Mexico.

MR. KASTLER: Bill Kastler, appearing for Gulf Oil Cor-Our witness is Mr. John H. Hoover. poration.

JOHN H O O V E R, a Witness, called by the Applicant, having been previously sworn, was examined and testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. KASTLER:

Q Mr. Hoover, are you the same witness who was sworn and gave the same testimony in the immediate preceding case?

Yes, sir.

Would you please state what Gulf seeks in this Application Number 2685?

We are requesting approval of a triple completion conventional for our Graham State "I" Well Number 2, in the Paddock, Blinebry and Drinkard Oil Pools.

Is this proposed triple completion similar to the triple completion just proposed in Case 2684?

Yes, sir, it is; it is practically identical.

Q Have you prepared a lease plat showing the location of this well?

A Yes, sir. It's marked Exhibit Number 1.

Explain what Exhibit Number 1 shows.

This shows the Graham State NCT-I lease outlined in red, and described as lots 3 and 4 of Section 19, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. Well Number 2, or proposed Well Number 2 is circled in red; it is located 1980 feet from the south line, and 560 feet from the west line of this Section 19. I would like to point out to the Examiner the proximity of the Well Number 2 to the previous well just discussed, the Mattern "A" Number 3, and our Graham State "I" Number 1. I would like to also point out that the Well Number 2 is only a location, has not been drilled; therefore, we do not have a log for this well



Q For Exhibit Number 2 in this case, have you prepared a schematic diagram showing the method of completion, and is it identical in most respects to Exhibit Number 3 in Case 2684?

A Yes, sir, it's identical in so far as the proposed

A Yes, sir, it's identical in so far as the proposed completion. Since the well has not been drilled, the footages, the proposed perforations, are all approximate, and the actual setting depths and the actual perforations of course will be determined when that well is drilled and it is logged. Otherwise, it is identical to the Mattern "A" Well Number 3.

MR. KASTLER: Mr. Examiner, in the interest of saving time, since the proposed mechanical installation in this well is identical to that proposed in Case 2684, which has just been heard, I would like to request that Mr. Hoover's testimony regarding Exhibit Number 3 in Case 2684 be incorporated into this record by reference, insofar as it applies to the physical installation and the bottom-hole pressures.

MR. NUTTER: Does that go as far as the casing, the cementing, tubing, and packer?

A No, sir; as far as the production tests, gravities, bottom-hole pressures which we might expect.

MR. NUTTER: I mean, Exhibit Number 2 in this case would indicate that the casing, cementing, tubing, packer installation in this well, would be similar to the previously discussed well?

A Yes, sir.

MR. NUTTER: Yes, sir, the testimony in the previous



case will be incorporated by reference in this case, Mr. Kastler. Do you have anything further then?

MR. KASTLER: Do you have anything further, Mr. Hoover?

- No, sir, I have not.
- (By Mr. Kastler) If granted, will this triple comple-Q tion prevent wast and protect correlative rights?
 - Yes, sir.
- Were Exhibits 1 and 2 prepared by you, or at your direction and under your supervision?
 - Yes, sir.

MR. KASTLER: I would like to move that these exhibits be entered.

MR. NUTTER: Gulf's Exhibits 1 and 2 will be entered in evidence in this case.

MR. KASTLER: This completes our direct examination.


