Would you please refer to that exhibit, Mr. Nutter, Q and to the docket that has been prepared and distributed here today, and point out any discrepancies that exist between the two documents?

There are no discrepancies between the two documents. A The pool extensions on the exhibit are as shown on the docket which was distributed at the hearing.

That is Paragraphs (a) through (i)? Q

Yes, sir. I would recommend that all the extensions as shown on the exhibit and the docket be adopted with the one exception, that I would recommend that Paragraph (f), the extension of the South Waterflow-Gallup Oil Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico be dismissed inasmuch as we recently reopened the spacing case in the South Waterflow Pool and certain pool redelineations were recommended by the applicant in that case, Humble Oil and Refining Company. think that the extension and the others can be worked out in the redelineation of the pool and at the pool rules.

Was Exhibit 1 prepared by you or under your supervision?

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on January 13, 1965, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 15th day of January, 1965, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:
