### APPLICATION

Comes now Schermerhorn Oil Corporation, a Delaware Corporation duly authorized to do business in the State of New Mexico, and shows to the Commission as follows:

- l. Schermerhorn Oil Corporation (Schermerhorn) is the operator of the Linam G No. 1 Gas Well in the Eumont Gas Field, located 1025' south of the north line and 1953' west of the east line of Section 5, Township 19 south, Range 37 east, Lea County, New Mexico. As a result of topographical conditions, it was necessary to drill said well at the described location, rather than the location prescribed by Rule 104(C)(II)(a), and Schermerhorn therefore applies for an exception pursuant to Rule 104(F). 
