ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on October 19, 1966, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 20th day of October, 1966, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the date of the December Regular Commission Hearing should be changed from December 14, 1966, to December 16, 1966, in order to avoid a conflict with a meeting of the Interstate Oil Compact Commission, and that the December Regular Commission Hearing should be held at 9 o'clock a.m., December 16, 1966, Morgan Hall, State Land Office Building, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the date of the December Regular Commission Hearing is hereby changed from December 14, 1966, to 9 o'clock a.m.,

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December 16, 1966, and that the December Regular Commission Hearing shall be held at Morgan Hall, State Land Office Building, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.



- ALLOWABLE: (1) Consideration of the oil allowable for November, 1966.
- (2) Consideration of the allowable production of gas for November, 1966, from thirteen prorated pools in Lea, Eddy and Roosevelt Counties, New Mexico. Consideration of the allowable production of gas from nine prorated pools in San Juan, Rio Arriba and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico, for November, 1966.

CASE 3476: In the matter of the hearing called by the Oil Conservation Commission upon its own motion for the purpose of considering changing the previously designated date for the regular Commission hearing in December, 1966. Date of said hearing would be changed from December 14, 1966, to 9 a.m. December 16, 1966, to avoid a conflict of dates with the annual meeting of the Interstate Oil Compact Commission.

CASE 3477: Application of Pan American Petroleum Corporation for special pool rules, Chaves County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks the promulgation of special pool rules for the Cato-San Andres Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico, including a provision for 80-acre proration units.

CASE 3478: Southeastern New Mexico nomenclature case calling for an order for the creation and extension of certain pools in Lea, Eddy, Chaves and Roosevelt Counties, New Mexico.

Transcript of Hearing



MR. PORTER: We will take up case 3476.

MR. HATCH: Case 3476, In the Matter of the Hearing called by the Oil Conservation Commission upon its own motion for the purpose of considering changing the previously designated date for the regular commission hearing in December, 1966. Date of said hearing would be changed from December 14th, 1966, to 9:00 A.M., December 16th, 1966 to avoid a conflict of dates with the annual meeting of the Interstate Oil Compact Commission.

If the Commission please, I would like to call Mr. Dan Nutter as a witness.

MR. PORTER: Have the witness stand and be sworn.
(Whereupon the witness was sworn.)

MR. DAN NUTTER

called as a witness, having been duly sworn, was examined and testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. HATCH:

Q Would you state your name and position for the record, please?

A Dan Nutter, Chief Engineer for the Oil Conservation Commission.

Q Mr. Nutter, are you familiar with the circumstances surrounding Case No. 3476?

A Yes, I am.

Q For what reason does the Commission desire to change the dates for the regular December Hearing as re-

flected in the docket?

A The Commission Rules and Regulations require that the dates for the regular hearings of the Commission be established and published prior to January 1st of each year. This, of course, was done in December of 1965, establishing the dates for all of the regular monthly hearings for 1966. At that time, or at the time these dates were established it was thought that the Interstate Oil Compact Commission would meet in Phoenix on December 5th, 6th and 7th of 1966; however, due to a rather important meeting at which several Governors will be present during that week when the Compact was scheduled to meet, the dates for the Compact meeting have been changed to the 12th, 13th and 14th of December to avoid the conflicts of dates with the Governors meeting.

It is therefore necessary to change the date of the Commission hearing, if it is not to conflict with the Governors Meeting, to either the 15th, 16th, 17th, 18th, 19th or 20th of December because the law requires that the Commission meet not later than the 20th of each month.

We selected December 16th, which is a Friday, as being the earliest date after the Compact meeting at which we could have a Commission meeting, and to avoid the conflict of dates, I would recommend that the Commission date for hearing be changed to Friday, December 16th.
