The well was completed October the 25th, '32; drilled to a total depth of 802 feet. We have no casing or cementing records. The initial potential was five barrels of oil and five barrels of water per day. And that's what we have.

Q Do you have anything further on that well?

A. No, that's all I have.

Now, refer to what's been marked as Exhibit Two, and would you summarize and explain to the Examiner what that exhibit contains?

A This is an unknown well, located in the southern -- south part of Bloomfield in Section 24, 29, 11.

This well is an unknown well. It flows water. The only casing in it is the surface pack and it flows a fairly large amount of slightly brackish water. It flows into the San Juan River.

That's all I have on that.

Q. Would there be any problem plugging this particular well?

A There could be a great deal of difficulty. It's been sitting there since the '30s. There could be a lot of junk in the hole. It's an open hole and it's marshy. We'd have to drain the area to get a rig in.

Q Do you have anything further on this well?

A. No, sir.

Referring to what has been marked as Exhibit Three, would you please summarize the contents of that exhibit?

In a marshy area within the city limits of Bloomfield. It's near a swamp. The well is sitting open, uncapped, flowing nothing. I checked the area for gas and the well is not making any gas or flowing any water. It's very near a home, however, in their backyard, in fact, and I think it could be a potential hazard.

And that's all I have on the well. It's also an unknown well.

Now, referring to what has been marked as Exhibit Four, would you please summarize that exhibit?

A This well is also located on the south side of Bloomfield. In fact, it may be out of the city limits. I'm not exactly sure where the city limits are. And it's also in a backyard. It's also sitting cased open; makes nothing. And I know the man — the man whose father supposedly drilled this well. He said it was drilled to 800 feet, but that's hearsay. I actually know nothing about it.

Mr. Gholson, do you know whether there are any valid bonds, plugging bonds, for any of these wells?

A There are no bonds.

Q In your opinion, Mr. Gholson, could the

A Yes, very possibly could cause waste of hydrocarbons. The sands could get charged up and in fact we had a case of a -- a few years ago of a well in Bloomfield that did blow out, and caught fire, and one of these same type of wells.

Mr. Gholson, are you prepared to recommend a plugging program at this time or would you prefer to wait to the actual time of plugging before you --

A. I would rather wait because we don't know what we're going to get into when we get into these wells.
