Ms. Venegas,

On behalf of Select Water Solutions, Envirotech Engineering & Consulting respectfully requests a transfer of the Burrata Reuse Containment and Recycle Facility (1RF-493) in Lea County, New Mexico currently held by Permian Resources Operating, LLC. (OGRD # 372165) to Select Water Solutions (OGRD # 289068). No changes to the design, operations, or procedures of the facility are being requested at this time, and the facility will continue to operate in accordance with its approved permit conditions. Select intends to use the facility for storage of treated produced water that has been recycled for commercial sale. Select will operate the facility until the permit expires, then will request an extension.

As part of this transfer, it is noted that the facility currently does not have financial assurance in place. Accordingly, Envirotech has prepared and included a facility closure plan and a closure cost estimate in accordance with NMOCD requirements. Upon the approval of this estimate, Select will post financial assurance in the amount determined on the attached closure cost estimate.

To help expedite this transfer, we have enclosed the following documents:

- Completed C-147 Form (Transfer) showing Select Water Solutions as the Operator
- An updated Closure Plan and Closure Cost Estimate showing Select Water Solutions, LLC as the Operator that is stamped by an Engineer Licensed in the State of New Mexico

Select Water Solutions is requesting the transfer of the Burrata Reuse Containment and Recycle Facility. This facility is located in Section 29, Township 21 South, and Range 32 East within Lea County, NM. The Burrata Reuse Containment and Recycle Facility consist of two (2) containments with a total operational volume of approximately 1,007,966-bbbls.

CLOSURE PLAN

In this plan, the underlined text represents the language of the Rule.

After operations cease, the operator will remove all fluids within 60 days and close the containment within six months from the date the operator ceases operations from the containment for use.

The operator shall substantially restore the impacted surface area to

1. The condition that existed prior to the construction of the recycling containment or
2. To a condition imposed by federal, state trust land, or tribal agencies on lands managed by those agencies as these provisions govern the obligations of any operator subject to those provisions.

EXCAVATION AND REMOVAL CLOSURE PLAN - PROTOCOLS AND PROCEDURES

The operator will remove all liquids from the pits and either:

- a. Dispose of the liquids in a division-approved facility, or
- b. Recycle, reuse, or reclaim the water for reuse in drilling and stimulation

The operator will close the recycling containment by first removing all fluids, contents, and synthetic liners and transferring these materials to a Division approved facility.

After the removal of the pit contents and liners, soils beneath the pit will be tested by collection of a five-point (minimum) composite sample, which includes stained or wet soils, if any. That sample shall be analyzed for the constituents listed in Table 1 of 19.15.34.14.

After review of the laboratory results:

- a. If any contaminant concentration is higher than the parameters listed in Table 1, additional delineation may be required, and the operator must receive approval before proceeding with closure.
- b. If all contaminant concentrations are less than or equal to the parameters listed in Table 1, then the operator will proceed to:
 - i. Backfill with non-waste containing, uncontaminated earthen material or
 - ii. Undertake an alternative closure process pursuant to a variance request after approval by OCD.

The operator will reclaim the containment's location to a safe and stable condition that blends with the surrounding undisturbed area.

Topsoils and subsoils shall be replaced to their original relative positions and contoured so as to achieve erosion control, long-term stability, and preservation of surface water flow patterns.

The disturbed area shall then be reseeded in the first favorable growing season following closure of a recycling containment.

CLOSURE DOCUMENTATION

Within 60 days of closure completion, the operator shall submit a closure report on Form C-147, including required attachments, to document all closure activities including sampling results and the details on any backfilling, capping or covering, where applicable. The closure report shall certify that all information in the report and attachments is correct and that the operator has complied with all applicable closure requirements and conditions specified in division rules or directives.

The operator shall notify the division when reclamation and re-vegetation are complete. Specifically, the notice will document that all ground surface disturbing activities at the site have been completed, and a uniform vegetative cover has been established that reflects a life-form ratio of plus or minus fifty percent (50%) of pre-disturbance levels and a total percent plant cover of at least seventy percent (70%) of pre-disturbance levels, excluding noxious weeds.

The NMOCD has reviewed the permit/registration transfer application submitted on 08/04/2026 by [372165] Permian Resources Operating, LLC (Application ID 610991) to transfer permit 1RF-493 – BURRATA REUSE CONTAINMENT AND RECYCLE FACILITY [fVV2227137236] from [372165] Permian Resources Operating, LLC to [289068] Select Water Solutions, LLC.

The transfer of permit/registration is approved with the following conditions of approval:

- [289068] SELECT WATER SOLUTIONS, LLC will comply with all conditions previously approved for permit 1RF-493 - BURRATA REUSE CONTAINMENT AND RECYCLE FACILITY [fVV2227137236]. No changes to the operations procedures, maintenance, and monitoring procedures, or closing procedures will be made and 1RF-493 - BURRATA REUSE CONTAINMENT AND RECYCLE FACILITY [fVV2227137236] must operate as originally permitted.
- A minimum of 3-feet freeboard must be maintained at 1RF-493 - BURRATA REUSE CONTAINMENT AND RECYCLE FACILITY [fVV2227137236] at all times during operations.
- If less than 20% of the total fluid capacity is utilized every six months, operations of the 1RF-493 - BURRATA REUSE CONTAINMENT AND RECYCLE FACILITY [fVV2227137236] are considered ceased and a notification of cessation of operations should be sent to OCD Permitting. A request to extend the cessation of operations, not to exceed six months, may be submitted using a C-147 Form to OCD Permitting. If after that 6-month extension period, 1RF-493 - BURRATA REUSE CONTAINMENT AND RECYCLE FACILITY [fVV2227137236] is not utilized at a minimum of 20% fluid capacity, no additional extensions would be granted, and the operator would be directed to remove all fluids and proceed with the closure requirements.

- [289068] SELECT WATER SOLUTIONS, LLC must inspect the 1RF-493 - BURRATA REUSE CONTAINMENT AND RECYCLE FACILITY [fVV2227137236] recycling containment and associated leak detection systems weekly while it contains fluids per 19.15.34.13(A). [333197] Ranger Water Midstream, LLC shall maintain a current log of such inspections and make the log available for review by the division upon request.
