That Administrative Order DC-20, heretofore issued by the Secretary-Director under authority granted by provisions of Order R-316, Rule 112-A, be and the same hereby is corrected to show the location of John M. Kelly's Gulf-Hair Well No. 1 as NW/4 SW/4 Section 8, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico; and said Order DC-20 in all other respects is hereby ratified and confirmed.

That this order correcting the record of said order be entered nunc pro tunc as of October 26, 1953, that being the date when said Order DC-20 was originally signed.
