DEDICATION AND TO FURTHER AMEND DIVISION ORDER NO. R-6141, AS
AMENDED, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO**

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on April 28, 1994, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Jim Morrow.

NOW, on this 2nd day of May 1994, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant, Conoco, Inc., seeks approval of a 480-acre non-standard Eumont Gas spacing and proration unit comprising the S/2 NW/4 and SW/4 of Section 17 and the NE/4 and N/2 SE/4 of Section 18, both in Township 21 South, Range 36 East, with said Eumont Gas Pool production to be simultaneously dedicated to said unit from the existing Meyer "A-1" Well No. 11 located in Unit H of Section 18; the existing Meyer "A-1" Well No. 20 located in Unit E of Section 17; and the proposed Meyer "A-1" Well No. 21 to be drilled in Unit M of Section 17. The proposed non-standard gas proration unit is to be a rededication of acreage to an existing non-standard gas proration unit previously authorized by Division Order No. R-6141, as amended.

(3) Prior to the hearing, by letter dated April 5, 1994, the applicant requested that this case be dismissed.


(4) The applicant's request for dismissal should be granted.
