This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on October 27, 1994 at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this <u>21st</u> day of November, 1994 the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

- (1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) The applicant, Manzano Oil Corporation, seeks approval of an unorthodox oil well location for its S. V. Sundown State Well No. 1 to be drilled 477 feet from the South line and 191 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 14, Township 10 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, to test the Devonian formation, Chaves County, New Mexico. The SW/4 SW/4 of said Section 14 is to be dedicated to said well to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit.
 - (3) Prior to the hearing, the applicant requested this matter be dismissed.
 - (4) Dismissal of this case should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

Case No. 11115 is hereby <u>dismissed</u>.
