BY THE COMMISSION:

It appearing to the Commission that Order No. R-1047,
dated September 16, 1957, does not correctly state the intended
order of the Commission in one particular due to clerical error,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Paragraph "(1)" on page 2 of Order R-1047,
Case No. 1301, be and the same is hereby corrected to read as
follows:

"(1) That a non-standard gas proration unit in the Tubb
Gas Pool consisting of the S/2 SE/4 and the SE/4 SW/4 of Section
17, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico,
be and the same is hereby established, said unit to be dedicated
to the Tidewater Oil Company Percy Hardy No. 2 Well located in
the SW/4 SE/4 of said Section 17."


2. That the correction and amendment set forth in this
order be entered nunc pro tunc as of September 16, 1957, the said
Order R-1047.
