- "(1) That a non-standard gas proration unit in the Tubb Gas Pool consisting of the S/2  $\underline{\text{SE}/4}$  and the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 17, Township 21 South, Range 37  $\underline{\text{East}}$ , NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, be and the same is hereby established, said unit to be dedicated to the Tidewater Oil Company Percy Hardy No. 2 Well located in the SW/4 SE/4 of said Section 17."
- 2. That the correction and amendment set forth in this order be entered nunc pro tunc as of September 16, 1957, the said 0rder R-1047.
