#### BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on October 5, 1995, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this <u>13th</u> day of October, 1995, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

#### **FINDS THAT**:

- (1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) The applicant, Phillips Petroleum Company, seeks approval to drill its Grayburg Deep Unit Well No. 11 at an unorthodox gas well location 416 feet from the South line and 2625 feet from the East line (Unit O) of Section 23, Township 17 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, to test the Pennsylvanian formation.
  - (3) Prior to the hearing, the applicant requested this matter be dismissed.
  - (4) Dismissal of this case should therefore be granted.

Case No. 11392 is hereby dismissed.
