BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on  
September 18, 1957, December 18, 1957, March 13, 1958, and again  
on January 14, 1959, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil  
Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to  
as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 2nd day of February, 1959, the Commission,  
a quorum being present, having considered the application and the  
evidence adduced, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required  
by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the  
subject matter thereof.

(2) That the preponderance of the evidence presented in  
this case indicates that one well will efficiently and economically  
drain 80 acres in the Bisti-Lower Gallup Oil Pool, San Juan County,  
New Mexico.

(3) That the Special Rules and Regulations for the Bisti-  
Lower Gallup Oil Pool, as set forth in Order No. R-1069-B, should  
be continued in effect until further order of the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


(1) That the Special Rules and Regulations for the Bisti-


(2) That this order shall become effective March 1, 1959.
