ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on September 18, 1997 at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this <u>24th</u> day of September, 1997, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

- (1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) The applicant, Mewbourne Oil Company, seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the base of the Abo formation to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the N/2 of Section 8, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, thereby forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within said vertical extent, which presently includes but is not necessarily limited to the Undesignated Empire Pennsylvanian Gas Pool and North Illinois Camp-Morrow Gas Pool. Said unit is to be dedicated to its Scoggin Draw "8" State Well No. 1 to be drilled at a standard gas well location 660 feet from the North line and 2250 feet from the East line (Unit B) of said Section 8.
 - (3) Prior to the hearing, the applicant requested this matter be dismissed.
 - (4) Dismissal of this case should therefore be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

Case No. 11639 is hereby dismissed.
