ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on May 14, 1998, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 28 day of May, 1998, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) By Division Administrative Order SWD-657, dated May 19, 1997, Manzano Oil Corporation was authorized to reenter and recomplete its State "22" Well No. 1 (API No. 30-025-04989), located 2310 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the East line (Unit I) of Section 22, Township 10 South, Range 37 East NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, as a salt water disposal well for the injection of Devonian produced water into the San Andres formation through the perforated interval from approximately 5,010 feet to 5,260 feet.

(3) The applicant in the immediate case, Yates Petroleum Corporation, seeks to rescind said Administrative Order SWD-657.


(4) Prior to the May 14, 1998 hearing, the applicant requested this matter be dismissed.
