THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CREATING, EXTENDING, REDESIGNATING, AND ABOLISHING CERTAIN POOLS IN LEA, EDDY, AND ROOSEVELT COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on December 18, 1957, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 30th day of December, 1957, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Pennsylvanian formation, said pool to bear the designation North Allison-Pennsylvanian Pool. Said North Allison-Pennsylvanian Pool was discovered by the Atlantic Refining Company State AE Well No. 1, located in the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 36, Township 8 South, Range 36 East, NMPM. It was completed September 14, 1957. The top of the perforations is at 9,652 feet.
- (3) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the McKee formation, said pool to bear the designation Justis-McKee Pool. Said Justis-McKee Pool was discovered by Tidewater Oil Company A. B. Coats "C" Well No. 8, located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 24, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM. It was completed October 8, 1957. The top of the perforations is at 7,325 feet.
- (4) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Siluro-Devonian formation, said pool to bear the designation Shugart Siluro-Devonian Gas Pool. Said Shugart Siluro-Devonian Gas Pool was

discovered by Pan American Petroleum Corporation Greenwood Unit Well No. 1, located in the SE/4 SE/4 Section 27, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, NMPM. It was completed February 20, 1957. The top of the perforations is at 12,655 feet.

vertical limits of the Vacuum Seven-Rivers Pool in order that the said vertical limits of said pool may be correctly defined. Further, that there is need for certain extensions to the redefined Vacuum Seven-Rivers Pool, the East Crossroads Devonian Pool, the East Echol Devonian Pool, the Gladiola Pool, the Penrose-Skelly Pool, the Bagley-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, and the Justis Gas Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico, and to the Cave Pool, the Grayburg-Jackson Pool, and the North Shugart Pool, all in Eddy County, New Mexico. Further, that inasmuch as the horizontal limits of the Gladiola Pool are being extended to include that area within the horizontal limits of the North Gladiola-Devonian Pool and the vertical limits of said pools are identical, that the North Gladiola-Devonian Pool can be abolished.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Pennsylvanian production, be and the same is hereby created and designated as the North Allison-Pennsylvanian Pool, consisting of the following described area:

(b) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for McKee production, be and the same is hereby created and designated as the Justis-McKee Pool, consisting of the following described area:

(c) That a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for Siluro-Devonian production, be and the same is hereby created and designated as the Shugart Siluro-Devonian Gas Pool, consisting of the following described area:

(d) That the vertical limits of the Vacuum Seven-Rivers Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, be and the same are hereby redesignated as the Yates formation and the pool name changed to Vacuum-Yates Pool, consisting of the following described area:
